




SOUTH DAKOTA-CANADA

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$313 MILLION IN 2017

SOUTH DAKOTA EXPORTED \$238 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$84M in oil cakes
- \$51M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$30M in pork)
- \$47M in ethanol
- \$8M in fats and oils
- \$6M in oil seeds




SOUTH DAKOTA IMPORTED \$75 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$34M in live animals
- \$20M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$15M in beef)
- \$5M in cereals
- \$4M in oil seeds
- \$3M in dried leguminous vegetables
