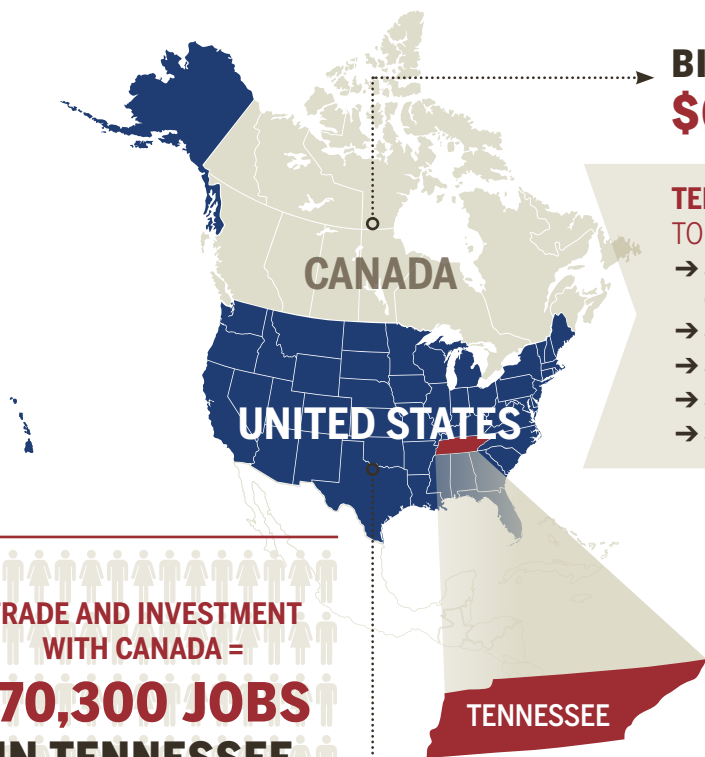

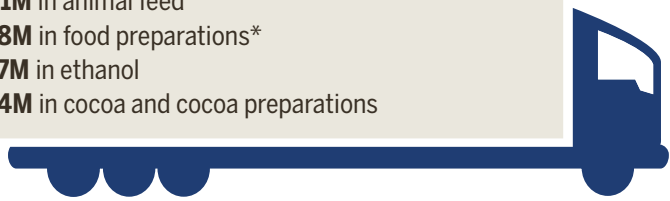
Let's keep a good thing growing!



BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$620 MILLION IN 2017

TENNESSEE EXPORTED \$240 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$111M in prepared cereal products (incl. \$61M in baked goods)
- \$21M in animal feed
- \$18M in food preparations*
- \$17M in ethanol
- \$14M in cocoa and cocoa preparations



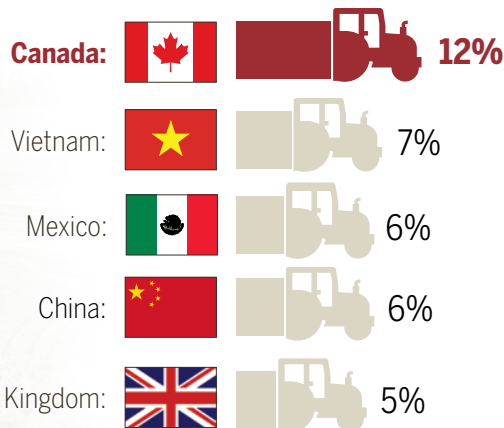
TENNESSEE IMPORTED \$380 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$79M in food preparations*
- \$77M in canola and mustard oils
- \$61M in prepared cereal products
- \$30M in sugars and sweets
- \$20M in cocoa and cocoa preparations

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
