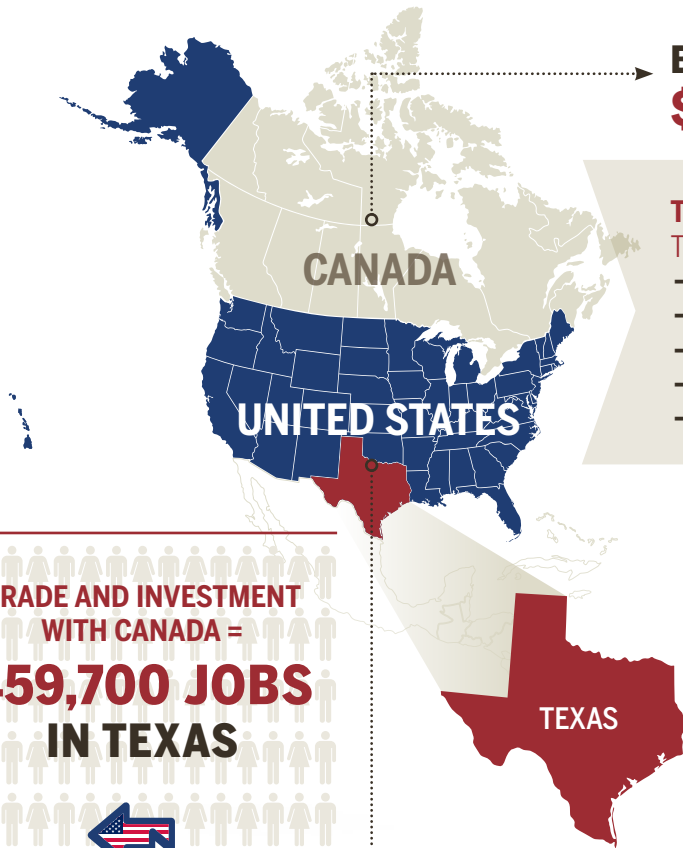

BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$1.9 BILLION IN 2017

TEXAS EXPORTED \$938 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$344M in fruits and nuts (incl. \$93M in avocados)
- \$145M in vegetables
- \$111M in food preparations*
- \$62M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$54M in beef)
- \$62M in beverages, spirits and vinegar



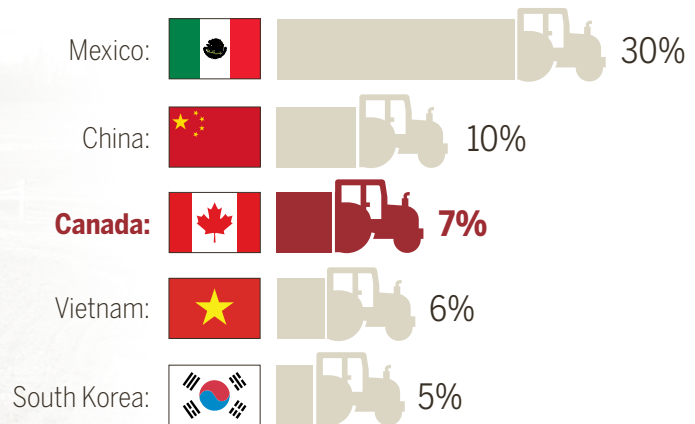
TEXAS IMPORTED \$918 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$174M in fats and oils
- \$144M in prepared cereal products
- \$137M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$88M in beef)
- \$115M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$66M in food preparations*

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
