BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$268 MILLION IN 2017

ARKANSAS EXPORTED \$191 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$59M in rice
- \$30M in fresh, chilled or frozen chicken
- \$24M in fertilized eggs
- \$24M in prepared meat
- \$12M in animal feed



ARKANSAS IMPORTED \$77 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

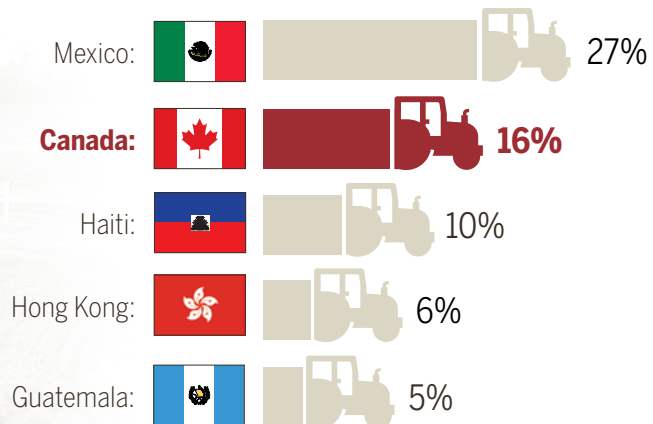
- \$17M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$11M in vegetables (incl. \$5M in potatoes)
- \$9M in canola oil
- \$8M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$6M in baked goods
