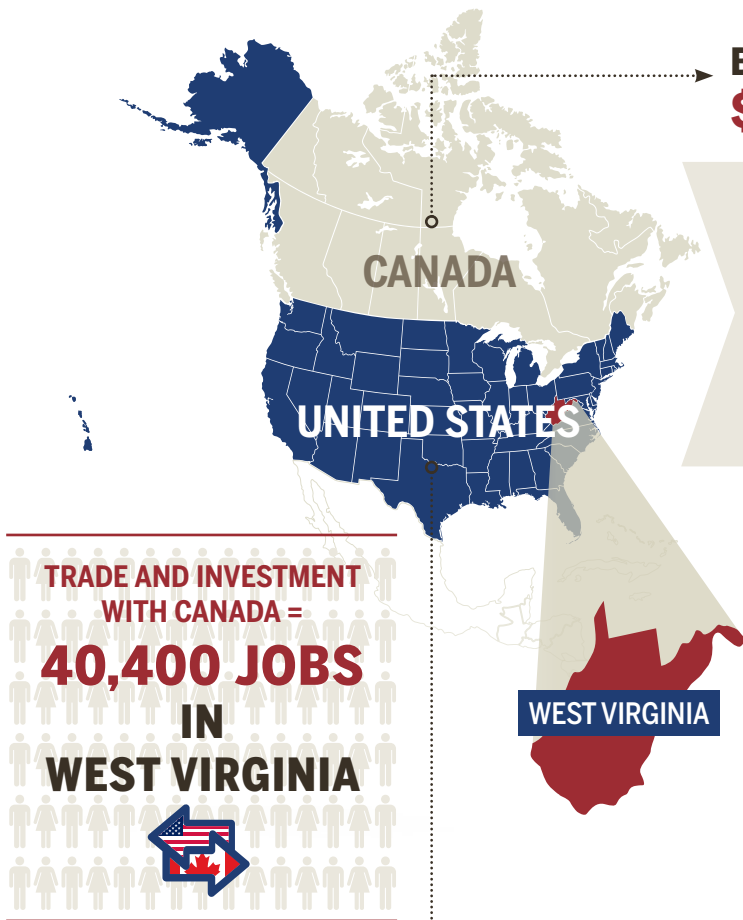

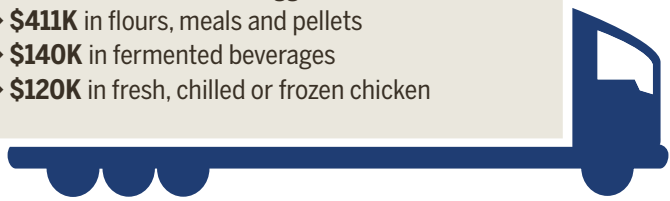
Let's keep a good thing growing!



BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$10 MILLION IN 2017

WEST VIRGINIA EXPORTED \$3 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$2M in live animals
- \$449K in fertilized bird eggs
- \$411K in flours, meals and pellets
- \$140K in fermented beverages
- \$120K in fresh, chilled or frozen chicken

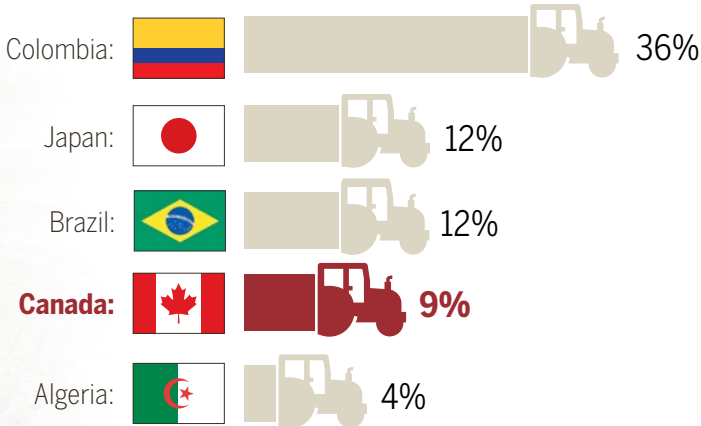


WEST VIRGINIA IMPORTED \$7 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$2M in fertilized bird eggs
- \$2M in beverages, spirits and vinegar
- \$883K in prepared cereal products
- \$716K in wheat gluten
- \$509K in vegetables
