

WISCONSIN EXPORTED \$1.3 BILLION

- → \$182M in prepared meat (incl. \$82M in sausages)
- → \$153M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- → \$135M in prepared cereal products

- → \$125M in cereals
- → \$110M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$60M in beef)
- → \$59M in live animals
- → \$48M in oil cakes
- → \$38M in bovine semen

*The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
