Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP)

On January 23rd, Canada and the 10 other remaining members of the Trans-Pacific Partnership concluded discussions in Tokyo, Japan, on a new Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP). Canada is proud to be part of the CPTPP, which is a trading block that represent 495 million people, with a combined gross domestic product (GDP) of CAD \$13.5 trillion, or 13.5% of global (GDP). This Agreement is expected to benefit Canada by boosting Canada's GDP by \$4.2 billion thanks to preferential access to the other ten CPTPP countries.

Outline of Opportunities in Japan

Japan is one of Canada's most important economic and commercial partners. Japan was the fourth-largest importer of agri-food and seafood products in the world, and Canada's third-largest market for agri-food and seafood.

Sodium Reduction in Processed Foods in Canada: An Evaluation of Progress toward Voluntary Targets from 2012 to 2016

In 2012, in an effort to reduce the amount of sodium in the food supply, Health Canada established voluntary sodium reduction targets for 94 processed food categories following extensive consultation with the food industry. Results show that sodium reductions in most categories of processed foods were modest. Specifically, industry met the targets in 14% of food categories. Source: Health Canada (January 2018)

Outline of Opportunities in China

As of 2016, Canada showed a market share of 4.85% of the Chinese agri-food and seafood market. Products where Canada has a strong presence in the processed food sector have been able to maintain a strong market presence because competitors are more focused on products where Canada has less interest. There is, however, strong competition in beef products, naturally healthy product ingredients, honey, and various oilseed products.

As of 2016, Canada was the second-largest supplier to the Mexican food market, with a share of 6.4% of the total \$C34 billion Mexican agri-food and seafood food market. Canada was also the second-largest supplier of processed foods, representing 4.7% of the C\$19.4 billion processed food market. 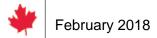
