<u>Sector Trend Analysis - Sauces, Dressings and Condiments in the United States</u>

The United States is the largest consumer and importer of sauces, dressings and condiments in the world, representing 20% of the world's retail consumption and 13% of the world's import share. This sector represents a dynamic opportunity for Canadian producers of sauces, dressings and condiments related products that are healthier due to the markets shift towards product offerings that are nutritious, healthy, and flavourful in nature.

■ What We Heard Report (CFIA) (Source: Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA))

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) has completed Phase III of the Food Labelling Modernization consultations and published a "What We Heard Report." CFIA collected feedback from consumers, industry, CFIA staff and other stakeholders on proposals to modernize Canada's food labelling system. Read more»

In Quebec, the gross domestic product (GDP) of the biofood processing sector increased by 1.2% per year on average from 2007 to 2016. ■ Minister MacAulay participates in Advancing Women in Agriculture Conference

The Government of Canada recognizes the important role women play in the agriculture and agri-food sector, as well as the Canadian economy at large. This is why Budget 2018 launched the Women Entrepreneurship Strategy to better support women entrepreneurs, to help them grow their businesses and to remove barriers to their success.

March 27, Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food, Lawrence MacAulay, and his wife, Frances MacAulay, attended the Advancing Women in Agriculture Conference in Calgary, where they spoke to participants about their experiences as dairy and potato farmers, and the importance of leadership roles for women in agriculture. ■ Agricultural Clean Technology program

Last March 19, the Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food Lawrence MacAulay, visited an innovative farm in St-Eugene, ON to announce the *Agricultural Clean Technology Program*. This \$25 *million, three-year investment* will help the agricultural sector reduce greenhouse gas emissions through the development and adoption of clean technologies. Provinces and territories are eligible to apply for federal funding through this program, and are encouraged to work with industry on projects that focus on precision agriculture and/or bioproducts. The program will launch on April 1, 2018. Read more.
