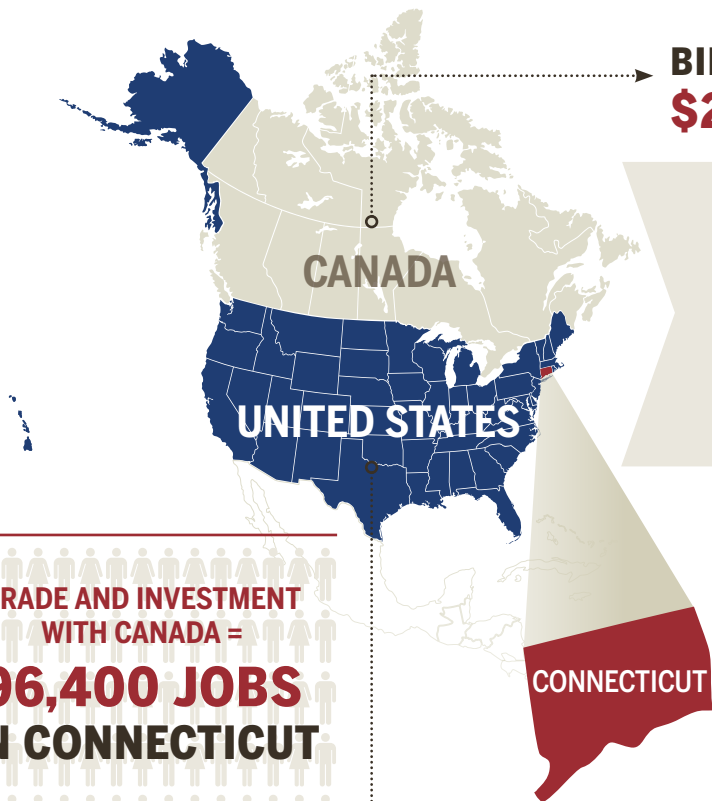




# CONNECTICUT-CANADA

**BILATERAL AGRICULTURAL TRADE = \$264 MILLION IN 2017**

**CONNECTICUT EXPORTED \$72 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$34M in animal feed
- \$7M in food preparations\*
- \$6M in vegetables (incl. \$2M in tomatoes)
- \$4M in chocolate products
- \$4M in baked goods



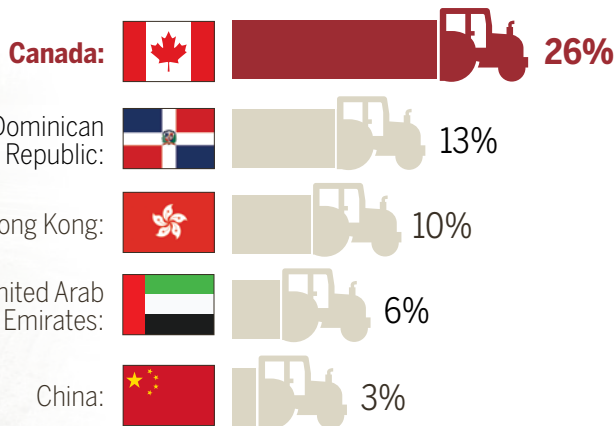
**CONNECTICUT IMPORTED \$192 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:**

- \$47M in prepared vegetables, fruits and nuts
- \$25M in fresh, chilled or frozen meat (incl. \$14M in beef)
- \$23M in vegetables
- \$19M in coffee
- \$18M in baked goods

\* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
