REVIEW OF ABORIGINAL DATA

This report reviews computerized data at the Ottawa Headquarters of Indian and Northern Affairs, Canada (INAC). The objectives of the exercise are two:

- a) determine what types of funding options are feasible on the basis of existing administrative data; and
- b) obtain basic data to conduct a sensitivity analysis of some of the options considered under the study Self-Government for Indian Bands: Funding Principles and Options.

The database review is structured in three sections. Section I provides a general overview of the project and the process followed, the main findings and some concluding observations.

Section II comprises the interview notes, which were derived from consultation with the various sections of the department regarding the availability of data at the individual band level.

Section III, finally, provides more detailed information and database descriptions obtained from various sources at INAC.

I. OVERVIEW

A. Process

The process began with an initial construction of a list of information requirements regarding the availability of data at the level of the individual band and, with the assistance of Tom Clark, INAC, an initial list of contacts within the department.

Interviews with the various sections of INAC were conducted during the period of April 3 to April 30, 1987. During this period, the interview format and questions were refined and a matrix of data availability was constructed (attached). The last step in the process was to request data on individual Indian bands from selected areas of the department in order to begin the construction of the data base for the sensitivity analysis of alternative funding formulae.

B. Findings

The main finding is that there exist a wide variety of databases at INAC. However, the use of these databases for analytical purposes encountered a number of difficulties. In part, at least, the source of the difficulty is that the databases are designed for operational rather than analytical purposes. Even accessing basic information on contributions and membership presented challenges: difficulty of accessing data from computer, changes of definitions over time, inflexible software.

BAND SERVICE PROFILE

The Management Improvement Project to develop a system that will provide managers with information indicating the extent to which programs and services are being administered and delivered by the Department, Indian Bands, Tribal Councils, Associations, Corporations and the Provinces has now been completed.

Previously, the Department did not have a reporting and tracking mechanism to monitor and evaluate progress with respect to the number, expenditures and types of services being administered and delivered by the Department, Bands, Associations, Tribal Councils and Provinces. The Band Service Profile (BSP) based on BCS/EAS provides information at the program service code and planning element levels. It displays expenditures and percentages by the Department (total) at these levels. Information is available for individual Bands or aggregated at the districts, region or national level. Grants and contributions to individuals are included in a BSP as departmental delivered services.


The BSP will permit managers to:

- better monitor and manage the transfer process;
- identify costs associated with transfers;
- assist in the forecasting, planning and budgetary processes for such transfers; and
- evaluate past progress.

BSP's can be obtained by individual Band(s), Tribal Council(s), Associations, Corporations, District(s), Region(s) and National levels, (see examples attached). Such information is available for the years 1982/83, 1983/84 and will be available for 1984/85 in July 1985 after fiscal period 15. A BSP reports only on previous years after the books have been closed.

At present, BSP's can only be accessed at headquarters by contacting the Director, Program Services, Indian and Inuit Affairs Program, and requesting a BSP by Band number (corporation, council, etc.), district or region number and state the level i.e., service code or planning element. National level reports are only available to headquarters. Should the demand for BSP's warrant regions to have direct access to BSP's on an annual basis, the costs would have to be examined.

TELEPHONES ARE SINGLE PARTY EXCHANGE. THE BAND RECEIVES MOST SOUTHERN MANITOBA RADIO STATIONS CBC, AND CKY-TV. CHLORINATED WATER IS PIPED TO USERS OBTAINED FROM DEEP WELLS. MOST RESIDENTS DO NOT HAVE INDOOR TOILET FACILITIES. THERE ARE SEVERAL RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

SUBJECT: ECONOMIC

THERE IS A DEVELOPING BUSINESS SECTION WHICH INCLUDES THE BAND OFFICE, THE COMMUNITY HALL, ADULT EDUCATION CENTRE, LIBRARY BUILDING, AND A GARMENT FACTORY. A SMALL GROCERY STORE/RESTAURANT OPERATES ON THE RESERVE. OTHER BUSINESSES ARE A LANDSCAPING FIRM, LAUNDROMAT, SERVICE STATION, AND A BULK FUEL DEALERSHIP.

SUBJECT: TREATY

THE PEGUIS BAND, FORMERLY ST. PETER'S BAND SIGNED TREATY 1 ON AUGUST 3, 1871 WITH HENRY PRINCE(MIS-KOO-KEE-NEW, OR RED EAGLE) AS CHIEF. TREATY 1 INVOLVED THE CHIPPEWA AND SWAMPY CREE TRIBES OF INDIANS IN THE AREA ROUGHLY COINCIDENT WITH THE PROVINCE OF MANITOBA AT THAT TIME.

IN 1907 THE ST. PETER'S BAND SURRENDERED THEIR LAND ON THE ST. PETER'S RESERVE 1A BUT NOT THEIR FISHING STATION 1A FOR THE PEGUIS RESERVES 1B AND 1C (FISHING STATION). THE PEGUIS RESERVE 1B IS IN THE TREATY 2 AREA. THE ST. PETER'S BAND WAS KNOWN AS THE ST. PETER'S BAND AND PEGUIS BAND FROM 1912 TO 1949, AND AS THE PEGUIS SINCE 1950, ACCORDING TO THE TREATY PAYLISTS. THE PEGUIS RESERVES 1B AND 1C AND ST. PETER'S FISHING STATION 1B CONTAIN EXCESS OF 75,000 ACRES.



GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETION OF APPLICATION

Note:

Under most of the Department's programs, this procedure for requesting funds to accommodate people reinstated under "Bill C-31" is, to a large extent, computerized. For the funding process to work effectively and efficiently it is essential that application form be completed accurately and correctly, according to the following directions.

Box 1 (Recipient Name)

This should reflect the name of the organization (Departmental responsibility centre, Tribal Council or Band) which requires funds to provide services to the reinstated individuals or families.

Box 2 (Recipient Number)

Insert the five-part number which distinguishes the recipient from all others. These numbers are assigned by Headquarters, and can be obtained from the "Chart of Applicants" provided to all Departmental offices.

Box 3 (Region Number)

Insert the Region Identifier Number currently used for the Band Support Funding database as shown in the "Chart of Applicants".

Box 4 (Funds managed by ...)

Place an "X" in the appropriate box.

Box 5 (Application Number)

This number is to be assigned by the applicant, starting at 01. Applications must be numbered sequentially - i.e. 01, 02, 03, 04, etc.

Box 6 (Page _____ of _____)

To ensure that the full application is considered it is necessary to indicate the page number and the total number of pages, even if only one is used. For example, in a two-page application it is necessary to indicate that the first page is No. 1 of 2, and the second is No. 2 of 2.

Box 7 (Family Name)

Enter the family name (maximum 15 letters) of the person for whom funding is required.

Box 8 (Given Name and initials)

Enter the given name and first initial (if any) of the individual, including all children in the family (e.g. Norman X). Use a maximum of 10 letters.

Box 9 (Family Number)

If a family number has been assigned by the registrar, enter the 6 digit number here.

Box 10 (Band Number)

Enter the 3 digit number of the band in which the individual is a member. If the individual is not a band member (i.e. is only on the general list) insert "999".

Box 11 (Age)

Enter an "X" in the applicable column for the individual.

Box 12 (Year of Return)

For an individual intending to return to reserve, enter a number according to the following schedule:

Anticipated Fiscal Year of Return	No.
1966-67	1
1967-68	2
1968-69	3
1969-70	4

If the individual does not intend to return to reserve, do not complete this column.

Box 13 (Services to be Provided)

Place an "X" in each column for which you need funds to provide services for the individual.

Box 14 (Applicant Certification)

This box must be signed by an authorized representative of the applicant. This signature will certify that, to the best of the applicant's knowledge, the facts reflected in items 5 to 11 are correct.

Box 15 (Departmental Verification)

This must be signed by the Regional Director of Reserves and Trusts to certify that reinstatement or registration under the new Indian Act has taken place.

Form 1 must be attached to Form 2 and forwarded to the appropriate *Departmental Officer of Primary Interest*, who is listed on the schedule provided.



INTRODUCTION

The basic purpose behind the development of this publication is to satisfy a long standing need for a self-contained "Manager's Guide" which will aid managers in utilizing financial management information to meet their operational responsibilities. In order to achieve this, the Guide addresses a number of questions, including:

- What decisions require financial information?
- Who manages financial resources?
- What information is available?
- How can it be used?
- When should it be used?
- Who can assist and in what way?
- What can a manager do to ensure that the information he and other managers need is available?

The Guide has been organized to answer these questions by discussing, first of all, in Chapter I, the major decision-making processes which require financial information. Once this perspective has been established, Chapter II identifies the information managers must provide to the financial system and indicates how this input can be relayed to the computer so that management reports may be produced. Then Chapter III outlines the reports available from the financial system and describes them in detail including their application to specific management functions.

As a further aid in utilizing the available financial information, Appendix I provides a data index which specifies which reports to consult for individual data items. While every attempt has been made to minimize the use of jargon, an explanation of the terms employed has been included as Appendix 2.
