HOUSING UNITS

A housing unit is defined as any self-contained dwelling unit on the reserve or settlement with at

least one bedroom and considered to be a main residence (as opposed to seasonal or vacation home)

irrespective of occupancy, level of completion or need for renovation or repair.

It could be a detached or semi-detached house, a mobile home, a row house or a multi-unit residence such as an apartment, condominium, duplex, triplex, etc., where each unit is to be counted separately.

SPECIAL PURPOSE Refers to self-contained housing, with at least one bedroom, used as a principal residence which is

located in a multi-unit building such as a duplex, triplex, or other type of apartment. It EXCLUDES multi-unit facilities where care and services are provided for seniors (as opposed to those which are essentially a residence for seniors), group homes, live-in alcohol or drug rehabilitation centre, and other social program residence facilities such as shelters for battered women. This figure is not

included in the Housing Units Total figure and any of the servicing reports.

#### **HOUSING CONDITION**

Replacement The number of housing units requiring replacement. It refers to those housing units which:

i) Are no longer habitable as a result of, for example, fires or natural occurrences; or

ii) Those declared unsafe or unfit for human habitation by a certified inspector because they no longer meet basic quality standards and cannot be economically renovated to an acceptable condition.

#### Minor Renovations

Defined as those renovations to houses which meet minimum National Building Code standards (i.e. no structural defects) but require normal preventative maintenance or repairs and upgrading such as replacing doors, windows, painting, etc. to maintain the useful life of the unit.

#### **Major Renovations**

Refers to a renovation which is required because a house fails to meet minimum National Building Code standards in several areas. This could include but is not limited to repairs

- extensive structural faults such as rotting or sagging foundations, faulty roof or chimney;
- unsafe outside steps or stairways in need of replacement;
- interior structural problems (e.g. falling plaster from walls and ceilings);
- defective plumbing and/or electrical wiring has to be replaced or upgraded.

#### INDOOR PLUMBING

Refers to housing units that LACK basic facilities i.e. NOT having an indoor toilet, an assured supply of hot and cold running water, a bath or shower.

#### **SERVICING**

#### Water

Water service is defined as an adequate supply of indoor potable water, under pressure, which meets the quality requirements of the Canada Drinking Water Guidelines and quantities referred to in DRM 10-7/40. "Housing units with water service" are defined by the following categories: Piped, Well, Trucked, Other Adequate. "Other Adequate" refers to the number of housing units that have adequate water service by means other than piped, well or trucked. Water services that require major renovation, upgrading or replacement are not to be included. "Service Unavailable" refers to the housing units that do not have potable running water indoors.

#### Sewer

Household sewage disposal is defined as adequate if the sewage is discharged from the housing unit to a piped collection system, septic tank, tile field or holding tank as part of a truck-haul system. "Housing units with waste water service" are defined by the following categories: Piped, Septic/Field, Septic/Trucked, Other Adequate. "Other Adequate" refers to the number of housing units that have adequate sewage service by means other than piped, septic field or septic truck. Sewage services that require repair, upgrading or replacement are not to be included. "Service Unavailable" refers to the housing units that do not have indoor waste water service.

#### **COMMUNITY SERVICES**

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Adequate refers to L.O.S.S. Program Directive 20-1, Vol. 1, PD6. 4 Electrical Transmission and Distribution System. Codes available are (0) Service Unavailable, (1) Grid, (2) Diesel Generated, Full Service, (3) Diesel Generated, Restricted Service, (4) Other Generated, Full Service, (5) Other Generated, Restricted Service.

ADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (1) Grid, (2) Diesel Generated, Full Service, (4) Other Generated, Full Service.

INADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (0) Service Unavailable, (3) Diesel Generated, Restricted Service, (5) Other Generated, Restricted Service.

#### Road Access

Road Access refers to year round road access to a community. Codes available are (0) Unavailable and (1) Available.

ADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (1) Available.

INADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (0) Unavailable.

### Waste Disposal

Solid Waste which is disposed of off-site (municipal, provincial,etc) in an environmentally acceptable manner or on a site on reserve assigned to receive solid waste, including spreading, compaction and covering waste with soil is considered adequate. Codes available are (0) Unavailable/Inadequate, (1) Adequate on Reserve, (2) Adequate Off-Reserve.

ADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (1) Adequate On-Reserve, (2) Adequate Off-Reserve.

INADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (0) Unavailable/Inadequate.

#### Fire Protection

Protection service provided on reserve either through a municipal type agreement with an adjacent municipality or an on-reserve Fire Department is considered adequate. Codes available are (0) Inadequate, (1) Adequate.

ADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (1) Adequate.

INADEQUATE is calculated from the codes (0) Inadequate.




