

By a general order the 13th May 1816, the management of Indian Affairs was placed under the control of the Commander of the Forces in the British North American Provinces.

By another general order, on the 13th April, 1830, the management of Indian Affairs in Upper Canada was placed under Sir John Colborne, the Lieut. Gov. for that Province, while that in Lower Canada remained unde Military control.
