# Canadian Forces Income Support



Canadian Forces Income Support (CFIS) is a tax-free monthly benefit that provides financial help if your household income is not enough to meet your basic needs.

# Who qualifies for CFIS?

You may qualify if you live in Canada and you are a Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) Veteran who:

- has successfully completed a rehabilitation program;
- has a low household income; and
- is currently looking for suitable employment; or
- has reached age 65 and no longer qualifies for the Earnings Loss Benefit.

The dependents of a deceased CAF Veteran may also qualify for this benefit.

# How do I apply?

Your VAC case manager can assist you with your application. If you do not have a case manager, the staff at any VAC office or Integrated Personnel Support Centre (IPSC) can assist you. #### **Key terms**

- Household income is determined in accordance with relevant legislation and considers taxable income (from employment, self-employment or other), rental income, interest and dividend income, and any government benefits you receive such as Old Age Security.
- Suitable employment is defined as an appropriate job or career for your level of education, training or experience.

### **Important information**

You need to apply for CFIS within six months following the termination of your Earnings Loss Benefit.

Similar to CFIS, the War Veterans Allowance provides financial support to low-income Veterans who served in the Second World War or the Korean War.
