
HEPATITIS C ARE YOU AT RISK?

Hepatitis C is a liver disease caused by the hepatitis C virus. It is spread through contact with infected blood.

Up to **246,000** individuals in Canada are living with chronic hepatitis C. **Nearly half** may not know they are infected.
