

#### FOREWORD

Information on the operation of the Canada Pension Plan is contained in the Canada Pension Plan Statistical Bulletin. The Bulletin makes this information available quarterly to industry, welfare organizations, all levels of government and interested persons.

Since the Plan came into operation in January 1966, contributions have been collected from employees, employers and self-employed people.

In January 1967, retirement pensions became payable. In February 1968, survivors' benefits were introduced. They comprise monthly widows' pensions, disabled widowers' pensions and orphans' benefits, as well as lump sum death benefits. In February 1970, monthly pensions became payable to disabled contributors, together with benefits for the children of disabled contributors.

The information presented in the Canada Pension Plan Statistical Bulletin pertains almost entirely to that part of Canada which lies outside the Province of Quebec. Except for members of the Armed Forces and the R.C.M.P., persons employed in the Province of Quebec are not covered by the Canada Pension Plan but by the Quebec Pension Plan, a virtually identical program administered by that province. A small number of beneficiaries under the Canada Pension Plan live in the Province of Quebec.

This issue contains information on the operations of the Canada Pension Plan Account; the Canada Pension Plan Investment Fund; number of beneficiaries; benefit payments; average benefit amounts; beneficiaries by age and sex; size of pensions; and causes of disability. As the program develops, more information will be available on these subjects and in other areas.

#### CONCEPTS USED

The following concepts are described under the number of the first table in which they appear.

#### TABLE 1.

#### Interest on Investments:

Interest received from contributions lent to the provinces. Excluded is interest accrued but not received.

#### Other Revenue:

Includes (a) penalties and interest on penalties paid by employers, (b) recoveries from the Quebec Pension Plan of its share of the cost of maintaining the Central Index for Social Insurance Numbers, (c) the Quebec Pension Plan's share of benefits in respect of dual contributors, and (d) miscellaneous revenues.

#### Administrative Expenditures:

Administrative costs charged to the Canada Pension Plan Account by the Departments and agencies involved: National Health and Welfare; National Revenue, Taxation; Supply and Services; Public Works; Unemployment Insurance Commission; and Department of Insurance.

#### TABLE 2

#### Investments Made In Period:

Contributions collected in any month are credited to the account in the following month and are made available for the purchase of securities in that following month. Actual investments in securities are made in the next following month, i.e. the second month following that in which they are remitted or collected.

#### Investment Fund - Quebec Securities:

The amounts purchased from the Province of Quebec arise out of contributions made to the canada Pension Plan by members of the Armed Forces and R.C.M.P. in that province.

#### TABLE 3

#### Benefits:

Includes any benefit paid during the month, viz., benefits paid for the first time during that month as well as benefits which commenced in a previous month and are still being paid.

#### Combined Pension:

Refers to the amount a person may receive as a retirement or a disability pension together with a widow's or a disabled widower's pension.

#### TABLE 5

#### Benefits Put Into Pay In Month:

The month a benefit or a pension is put into pay is the month in which payments are first issued, which may be later than the effective month of that benefit. All benefits being reported for the first time reflect the interim amount of the benefit.

#### TABLE 6

#### Payments:

Includes retroactive payments.

#### TABLE 10

#### Average Monthly Amount:

Does not take into account retroactive payments for earlier months.

#### TABLE 12

#### Gross Amount:

Does not take into account a reduction due to the application of the earnings test, or any adjustment between an interim and a final award. Includes retroactive payments, if any.

#### Age:

Unless otherwise specified in table titles, the age is that at the end of the month for which the data are tabulated.

#### TABLE 27

#### Class of Principal Diagnosis:

The nomenclature for the classes of principal diagnosis is taken from the Eight Revision International Classification of Diseases, Adapted for Use in the United States.

#### SOURCES OF DATA

The tables have been obtained from programs developed in cooperation with and tabulated by the Departmental Services Officer from the files of the Claims Section of the Canada Pension Plan, and from Departmental Services Accounting Records.

#### SYMBOLS

The symbol (-) is used throughout the bulletin to indicate nil, or an amount less than can be shown with number of digits used. The letter "r" indicates figures revised since the previous issue of the Bulletin.

#### ROUNDING

Due to rounding, data may not add to totals shown.

#### FINANCES

Canada Pension Plan Account - The excess of revenue over expenditure has increased from year to year since January 1966. This situation arises, in the earlier years of such a program, from the fact that entitlement to benefits is based upon the prior payment of contributions but this entitlement may not occur until a number of years after the contributions have been paid.

<u>Canada Pension Plan Investments</u> - Contributions for the month of January are credited to the account in February and are invested in March, and so on for each month.

Securities that have been purchased by the investment fund have a maturity period of twenty years.

#### BENEFIT STATISTICS

The principal factors shown are the numbers of beneficiaries, amounts of payments, and average monthly benefit amounts. These are classified by type of benefit, by fiscal year and by month, by province, by age and sex, and by size of monthly pension. The classes of principal diagnosis of disabled contributors are included in the Bulletin.

There are three types of benefits under the Canada Pension Plan: Retirement Pension; Disability Benefits comprised of pensions for disabled contributors and of benefits for their dependent children; and Survivors' Benefits consisting of widows' pensions, disabled widowers' pensions, orphans' benefits, and lump sum death benefits. With the exception of lump sum death benefits, all benefits are paid monthly.

Retirement Pensions became payable in January 1967, Survivors' Benefits in February 1968 and Disability Benefits in February 1970.

Monthly benefits in pay in December are adjusted upwards in January according to the change in the Pension Index. Thus, all benefits paid in December 1967, 1968, 1969, 1970, and 1971 were adjusted upwards by 2 percent in January 1968, 1969, 1970, 1971 and 1972 respectively.

Maximum Benefits - The average amounts of benefits shown in the tables may be compared with the maximum rates of benefits payable. The maximum retirement pension that may be put into pay will continue to rise each month during the transitional period which ends December 1975. For example, for January 1967, it was \$10.42; for January 1968, \$20.97; for January 1969, \$31.88; for January 1970, \$43.33; for January 1971, \$55.21; for January 1972, \$67.50 and for March 1972, \$69.38.

The maximum disability pension put into pay in 1970 rose each month from February to December inclusive. This is due to the fact that the legislation requires that a contributor's pensionable earnings, on which his disability pension is based, be averaged over a minimum of 60 months. For example, the maximum disability pension commencing in February 1970 was \$92.88; the maximum such pension commencing in December 1970 was \$106.43. The maximum disability pension payable in any month of 1971 was \$109.88; in 1972 it is \$111.98.

For a widow or a disabled widower under age 65 the maximum monthly rate of pension put into pay in 1968 was \$64.82. In 1969 it was \$65.85; in 1970. \$67.16; in 1971 it was \$68.47; and in 1972 it is \$69.79. For a widow or a disabled widower age 65 or more it was \$62.92 in 1968, \$64.75 in 1969, \$65.00 in 1970, \$66.25 in 1971, and is \$67.50 in 1972.

Orphans' benefits and benefits for children of disabled contributors are payable directly to orphans and children age 18-24 inclusive provided they are in full time attendance at school or university. This condition does not apply to orphans and children under age 18. Benefits for orphans and children of disabled contributors under age 18 are paid to the person who has custody and control of such children.

Orphans' benefits were payable in 1968 at the basic rate of \$25.50 a month. In 1969 the basic rate became \$26.01; in 1970, \$26.53; in 1971, \$27.06. The basic rate for 1972 is \$27.60. The basic rate is the rate for each of the first four orphans in a family. The rate for each orphan in excess of four is one half the basic rate. The total amount for all children in a family is divided equally among them, however.

Benefits for the children of disabled contributors have been payable since February 1970, at the same rates as orphans' benefits.

The maximum death benefit payable to the estate of a contributor who died in 1968 was a lum sum of \$510.00. In 1969, the maximum amount was \$520.00; in 1970, it was \$530.00; in 1971, it was \$540.00; and in 1972, it is \$550.00.




