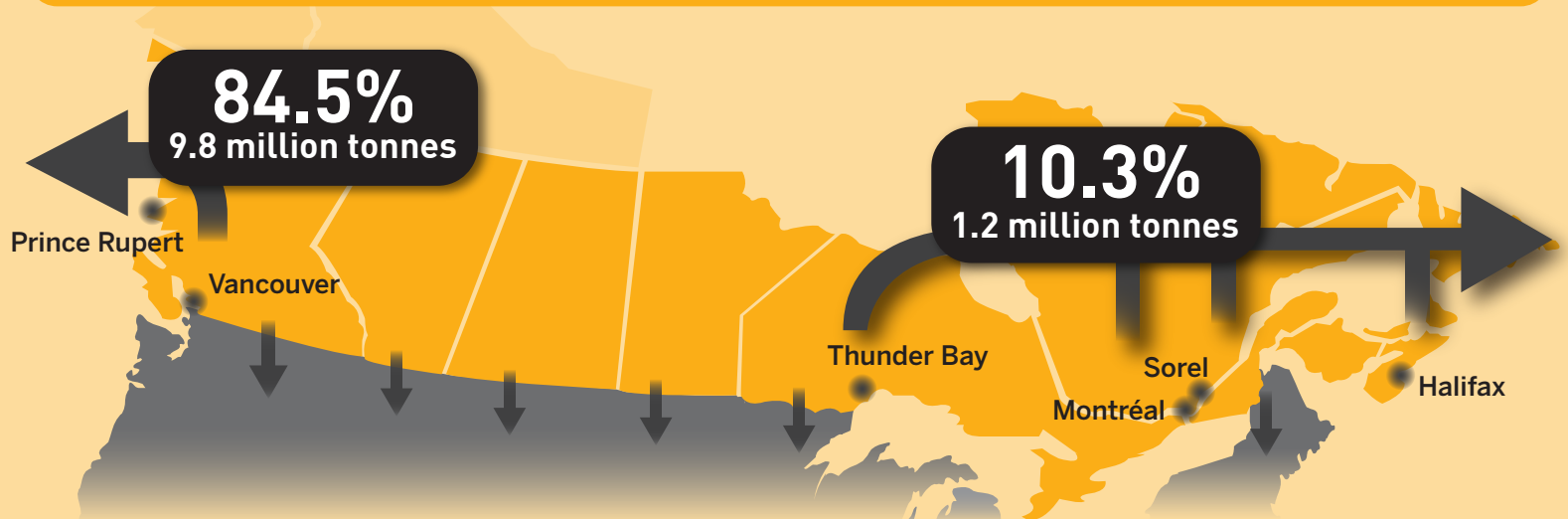
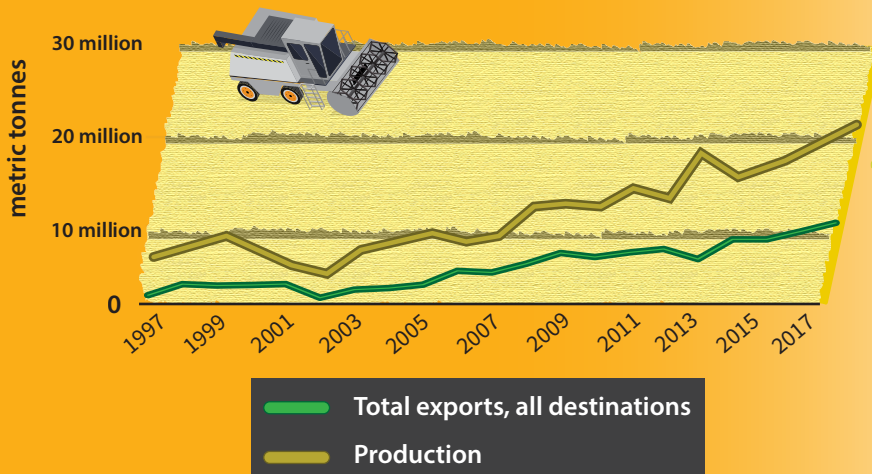


Fields of gold: Canola exports and production

In 2017, Canada produced 21.3 million tonnes of canola.¹ The majority of canola exports (84.5%) were moved through the Vancouver and Prince Rupert port terminals while over 10% were shipped through the Atlantic Ocean.²



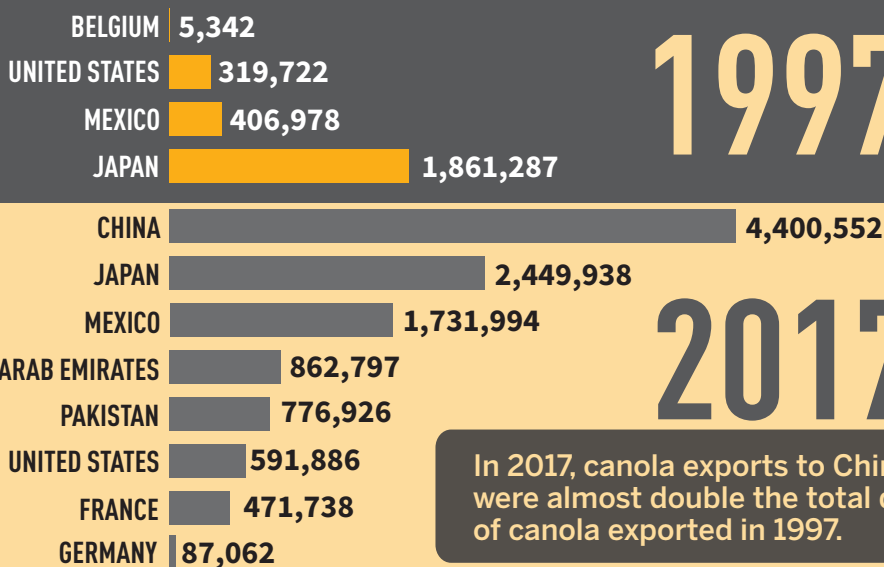
Canola production has more than tripled in the last 20 years.¹ Canada exports close to half of the canola that it produces annually.²



Seeded area for canola has almost doubled over the past 20 years.¹



International destinations for Canadian canola have become more diverse over time (quantities in metric tonnes).²



In 2017, canola exports to China alone were almost double the total quantity of canola exported in 1997.

Canada's canola exports were valued at **\$6.5 billion** in 2017.²

Canola accounted for **\$10.0 billion** in farm cash receipts³ in 2017.
