## Comparing US and Canadian trade figures

In 2016, Canada reported a US\$24.4 billion trade in goods surplus with the United States, while from the US perspective this surplus was reported as US\$16.3 billion, a difference of US\$8.1 billion.

Building permits climb in December 2017
Canadian municipalities issued $\$ 8.1$ billion in building permits in December, up 4.8\% following a $7.3 \%$ decline in the previous month. The increase stemmed from higher construction intentions in the residential sector. Across Canada, all components climbed in 2017, up $10.4 \%$ from the previous year.

## Part-time employment falls in January, while full-time is up

Following two months of increases, employment fell by 88,000 in January. Parttime employment declined (-137,000), while full-time employment was up $(+49,000)$. At the same time, the unemployment rate increased by 0.1 percentage points to $5.9 \%$.

## Canola stocks hit a record high

Canola stocks reached a record high 14.1 million tonnes as of December 31, 2017, up $5.7 \%$ from the same date in 2016. The gain in stocks reflects record canola production in 2017, at 21.3 million tonnes.
