




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# QUARTERLY ECONOMIC SUMMARY: STATISTICAL SUPPLEMENT

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## **Preface**

The Quarterly Economic Summary: Statistical Supplement complements the description of the economic conditions contained in the "Current Economic Indicators" and "Quarterly Economic Summary" publications. The analysis provided by these publications is based mainly on data provided by the Statistical Supplement, including analytically useful transformations such as percentage changes, ratios, smoothed time series, etc. Because of this emphasis on analytical transformation of the data, the publication is not meant to serve as a compendium of source data on the macro-economy. Users requiring such a compendium are urged to consult the Canadian Statistical Review.

In tables containing percentage changes, monthly values are the percentage changes from the previous month, quarterly values are the percentage changes from the previous quarter, and annual values are the percentage changes from the previous year.

## **CANSIM Note**

CANSIM<sup>†</sup> (Canadian Socio-Economic Information Management System) is Statistics Canada's computerized data bank and its supporting software. Most of the data appearing in this publication, as well as many other data series are available from CANSIM via terminal, on computer printouts, or in machine readable form. Historical and more timely data not included in this publication are available from CANSIM.

The numbers at the top of most columns identify the underlying series on CANSIM.
