

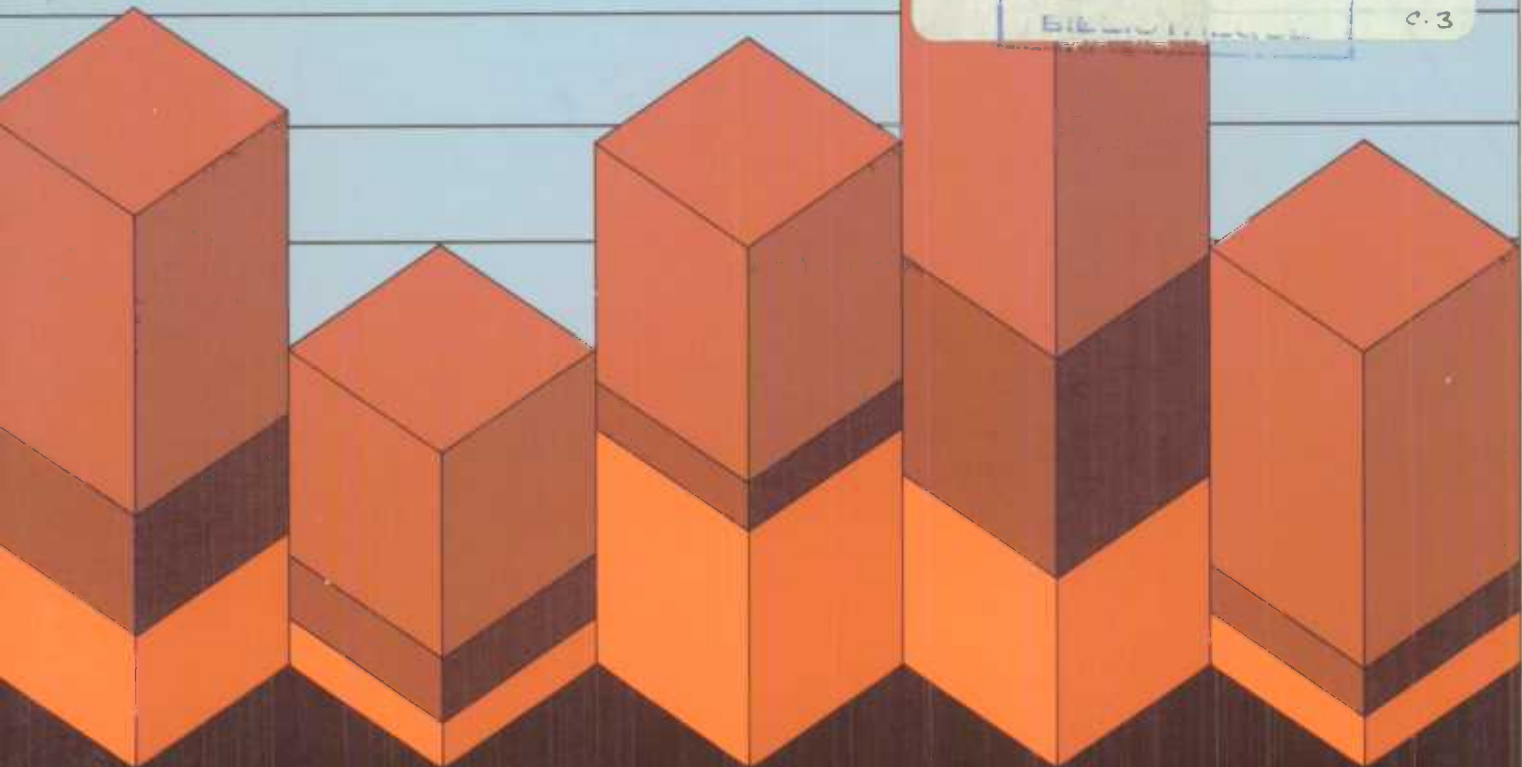
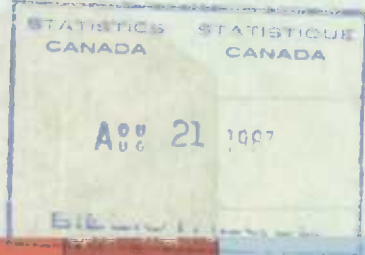

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## Preface

The purpose of the **Quarterly Economic Summary** is to provide a quarterly description of macro-economic conditions and thereby to extend the availability of information on the macro-economy provided by the System of National Accounts.

The publication provides a more detailed analysis than is available in the monthly **Current Economic Indicators**. In particular, the sectoral analysis of the data provides relevant information on industrial and regional developments. Tables of the source data, as well as transformations useful for current economic analysis are available in the **Quarterly Economic Summary: Statistical Supplement**.

Technical terms and concepts used in this publication that may be unfamiliar to some readers are briefly explained in the glossary. More extensive feature articles will appear in this publication from time to time explaining these technical terms and concepts in more detail.

CANSIM† (Canadian Socio-Economic Information Management System) is Statistics Canada's computerized data bank and its supporting software. Most of the data appearing in this publication, as well as many other data series are available from CANSIM via terminal, on computer printouts, or in machine readable form.
