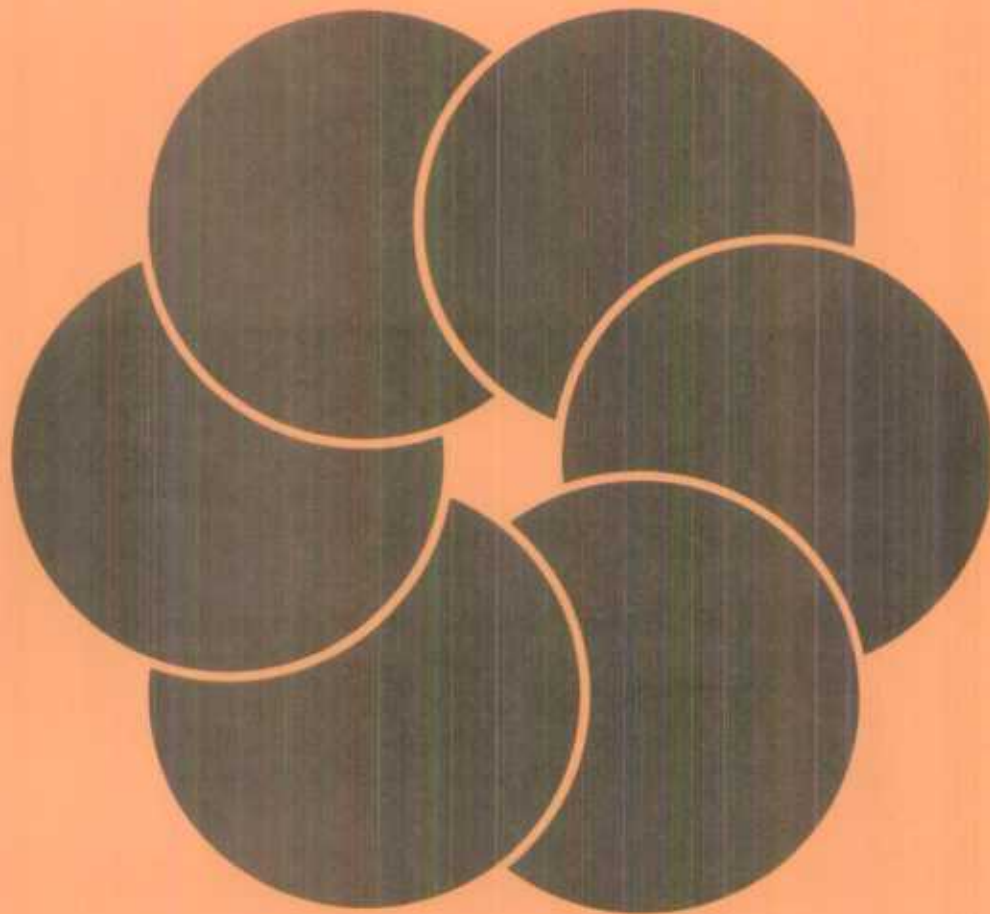

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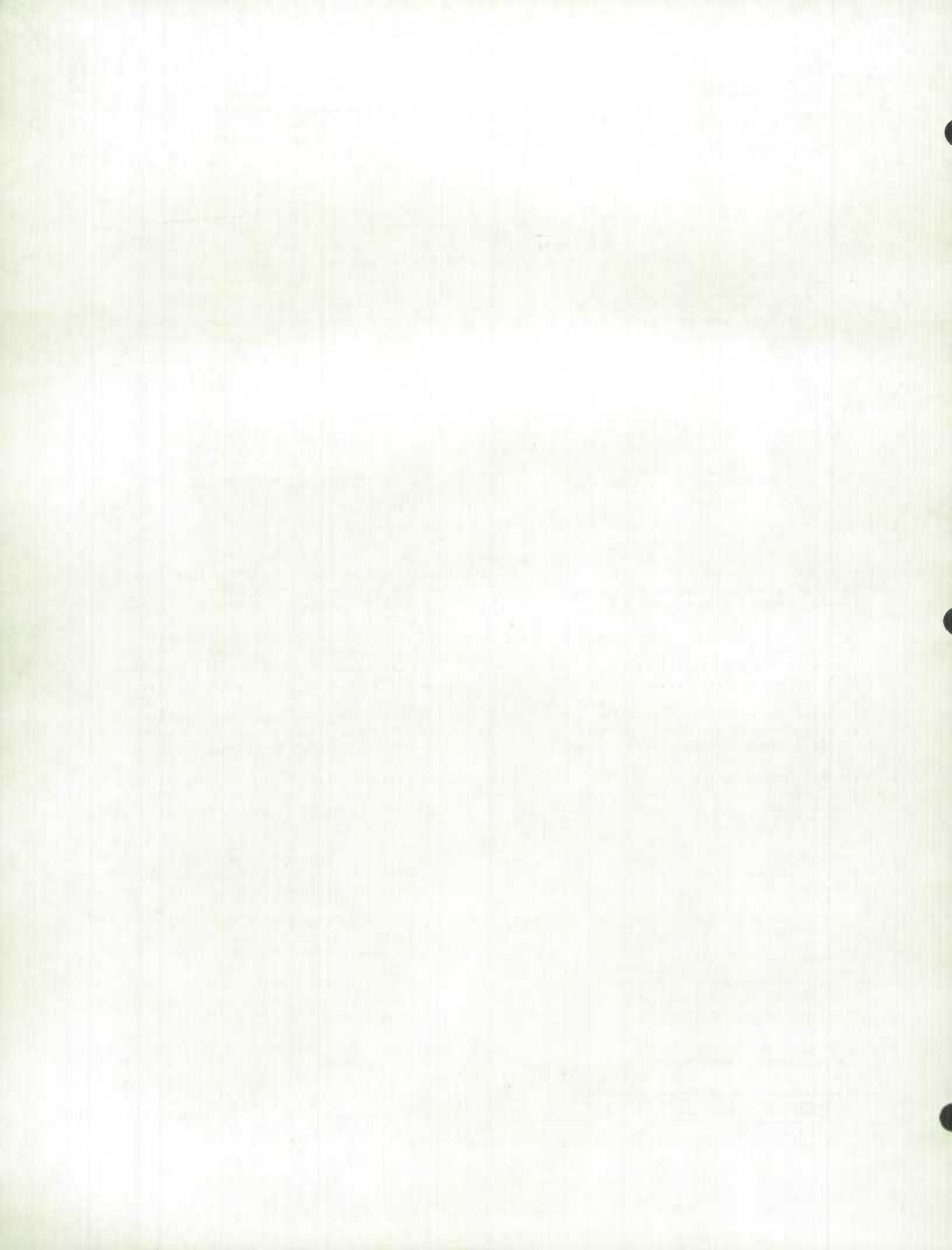
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## I. Introduction

Since the early nineteen fifties, Statistics Canada has conducted periodic surveys of incomes of families and individuals. The list of published reports is reproduced on the back cover. The survey sample, initially restricted to non-farm households, was expanded for the 1965 income survey and since then it has represented virtually all private households in Canada (with minor exceptions).<sup>(1)</sup> Surveys are now conducted annually.

The latest survey was conducted in April 1974 when individuals in approximately 35,000 households across the country were asked to supply information on incomes received in 1973. This report presents preliminary estimates derived from only partially edited survey data. It is expected that these estimates will be somewhat revised when the final report Income Distributions by Size in Canada, 1973, Catalogue 13-207 is published early in 1975.

Since the estimates in this report are based on a sample, they are subject to sampling variability. Moreover, as in all field surveys of income, the figures are subject to errors of non-response and response.

## II. Summary

### Families and Unattached Individuals

The average income of families rose from \$11,300 in 1972 to an estimated \$12,532 in 1973, an 11% increase over the year. If this increase is adjusted for changes in the Consumer Price Index in the corresponding period, the gain is reduced to 3%.

The average income of unattached individuals increased by 14%, from \$4,572 in 1972 to \$5,210 in 1973 and for all units, families and unattached individuals combined, it rose from \$9,525 to \$10,574, an increase of 11% over the year. The proportion of family units receiving an annual income of less than \$5,000 dropped from 30.1% in 1972 to 26.2% in 1973 and that of units receiving \$15,000 or more annually increased from 16.7% to 22.9%.

## I. Introduction

Depuis le début des années cinquante, Statistique Canada mène des enquêtes périodiques sur les revenus des familles et des particuliers. La liste des bulletins publiés à ce sujet est reproduite au dos de la couverture. L'échantillon de l'enquête, qui, à l'origine, ne comprenait pas les ménages agricoles, a été élargi à l'occasion de l'enquête sur le revenu de 1965 et a, depuis lors, représenté pratiquement tous les ménages privés du Canada (à quelques exceptions près)<sup>(1)</sup>. Les enquêtes ont lieu désormais tous les ans.

Au cours de la dernière enquête, menée en avril 1974, on a demandé aux particuliers d'environ 35,000 ménages choisis dans tous le pays de fournir des renseignements sur leurs revenus de 1973. Le présent bulletin contient les premières estimations fondées sur des données d'enquête qui n'ont été que partiellement contrôlées. Ces estimations seront sans doute rectifiées lors de la publication (au début de 1975) du bulletin définitif Répartition du revenu au Canada selon la taille du revenu, 1973, numéro 13-207 au catalogue.

Étant donné que les estimations de ce bulletin sont fondées sur un échantillon, elle sont sujettes à la variabilité d'échantillonnage. De plus, comme pour toutes les enquêtes sur le revenu menées sur le terrain, les chiffres peuvent être entachés d'erreurs de réponse et de non-réponse.

## II. Résumé

### Familles et personnes seules

De 1972 à 1973, le revenu moyen des familles a augmenté de 11 %, passant de \$11,300 à \$12,532 (chiffre estimatif). Après indexation de cette augmentation sur l'indice des prix à la consommation, la progression réalisée n'est plus que de 3 %.

Le revenu moyen des personnes seules a augmenté de 14 %, passant de \$4,572 en 1972 à \$5,210 en 1973; pour l'ensemble des unités (familles et personnes seules réunies), le revenu moyen est passé de \$9,525 à \$10,574, soit 11 % de plus. Le pourcentage d'unités familiales recevant un revenu annuel de moins de \$5,000 est tombé de 30.1 % en 1972 à 26.2 % en 1973, alors que celui d'unités recevant \$15,000 et plus par an est passé de 16.7 % à 22.9 %.

Individuals with Income

The average amount of income received by persons 14 years of age and over(2) increased by 9%, from \$5,828 in 1972 to \$6,358 in 1973. For men, the average income rose by 9%, from \$7,633 to \$8,310 and for women, it increased by 11%, from \$3,243 to \$3,591.

III. Families and Unattached Individuals with Low Incomes

Table 7 indicates the incidence of low incomes among families and unattached individuals in 1973, while Table 8 compares some selected characteristics of families and unattached individuals with low incomes vis-à-vis those with higher incomes. In order to delineate low income units from other family units two sets of low income cut-offs are used. The first set, referred to as the updated cut-offs, was determined by adjusting the low income lines developed in 1961 for increasing prices, as reflected in the Consumer Price Index. These income limits were selected on the basis that urban families with incomes below these limits usually spent 70% or more of their income on food, shelter and clothing.(3)

The second set, called the revised cut-offs, was determined from an analysis of 1969 Family Expenditure data. As a result, the revised low income limits reflect more recent consumption patterns of Canadian families. As the overall ratio spent on food, shelter and clothing had declined, families who on average spent 62% or more of their income on this type of goods and services were considered to be in straitened circumstances.(4) These limits were differentiated by size of area of residence in addition to family size.

Particuliers ayant un revenu

Le revenu moyen des personnes de 14 ans et plus(2) a augmenté de 9 %, passant de \$5,828 en 1972 à \$6,358 en 1973. Le revenu moyen des hommes a progressé de 9 % (de \$7,633 à \$8,310), tandis que celui des femmes a augmenté de 11 %, passant de \$3,243 à \$3,591.

III. Familles et personnes seules à faible revenu

Le tableau 7 indique la répartition des familles et des personnes seules à faible revenu pour 1973, alors que le tableau 8 met en comparaison certaines caractéristiques des familles et personnes seules à faible revenu avec celles des tranches de revenus plus élevés. Afin de distinguer les unités à faible revenu des autres unités familiales, on a établi deux seuils de faible revenu. Le premier, ou seuil actualisé, a été déterminé en ajustant les limites de faible revenu établies en 1961 aux prix plus élevés fournis par l'Indice des prix à la consommation. Ces limites sont fondées sur le principe que les familles urbaines dont le revenu se situe en deçà de ces limites consacrent habituellement 70 % ou plus de leur revenu à l'alimentation, au logement et à l'habillement(3).

Le second seuil, ou seuil révisé, a été déterminé à partir d'une analyse des données de l'enquête de 1969 sur les dépenses des familles. Il en résulte que les limites révisées de faible revenu reflètent les tendances de consommation plus récentes des familles canadiennes. Comme, dans son ensemble, la proportion du revenu que les Canadiens consacrent à l'alimentation, au logement et à l'habillement a diminué, les familles qui, en moyenne, ont dépensé 62 % ou plus de leur revenu pour l'achat de ces biens et services sont considérées comme des familles à faible revenu(4). Ces limites ont été

Using the updated cut-offs the preliminary estimates for 1973 incomes indicate that the incidence of low income among families decreased from 13.7% in 1972 to 12.0% in 1973. The incidence of low income among unattached individuals decreased from 34.7% in 1972 to 31.6% in 1973.

Sur la base des seuils actualisés, les premières estimations des revenus de 1973 indiquent que la proportion de faibles revenus chez les familles est tombée de 13.7 % en 1972 à 12.0 % en 1973. La proportion de faibles revenus chez les personnes seules est tombée de 34.7 % en 1972 à 31.6 % en 1973.

Estimates based on the revised cut-offs show that the incidence of low income among families was 14.1% and for unattached individuals it was 39.6% in 1973.

Sur la base des seuils révisés, la proportion de faibles revenus en 1973 a été de 14.1 % chez les familles, contre 39.6 % chez les personnes seules.

IV. Definitions

IV. Définitions

Family

Famille

The family in this publication is defined as a group of individuals related by blood, marriage or adoption, who shared a common dwelling unit at the time of the survey (April 1974).

On définit ici la famille comme un groupe de personnes unies par le sang, par alliance ou par adoption et qui partageaient le même logement au moment de l'enquête (avril 1974).

Unattached Individual

Personne seule

An unattached individual is a person living by himself or rooming in a household where he is not related to other household members.

Une personne seule est une personne qui vit seule ou qui occupe une chambre dans un ménage sans avoir de lien de parenté avec d'autres membres du ménage.

Family Unit

Unité familiale

The term family unit is used to designate collectively unattached individuals and families of two or more members.

Le terme unité familiale désigne collectivement les personnes seules et les familles de deux personnes et plus.

Income

Revenu

In this report the term income means total money income received in the year 1973, before deduction for such items as income tax, unemployment insurance and pension fund contributions. It consists of wages and salaries, net income from self-employment, investment income, government transfer payments and miscellaneous other components such as retirement pensions, annuities, scholarships, alimony and the like.

Dans ce bulletin, le mot revenu désigne le revenu monétaire total reçu en 1973, avant déduction de l'impôt sur le revenu, des cotisations d'assurance-chômage et des cotisations à un régime de pensions. Il comprend les salaires et traitements, le revenu net provenant d'un emploi autonome, les revenus de placements, les transferts du gouvernement ainsi que les revenus divers tels que les pensions de retraite, les rentes, les bourses d'études, les pensions alimentaires et ainsi de suite.

Receipts not Counted as Income

Receipts of gifts, lump-sum settlements from insurance policies, income tax or pension plan refunds, capital gains and losses, receipts from the sale of assets, and inheritances or bequests are not classified as income nor are such items as income in kind - food and fuel produced on own farm, free meals or living accomodation, etc.

Recettes non comptées comme revenu

Sont exclus du revenu: les dons, les règlements forfaitaires de polices d'assurance, les remboursements d'impôt sur le revenu ou de cotisations à des régimes de pensions, les gains ou les pertes en capital, le produit de la vente de biens, les héritages et les donations ainsi que les avantages en nature: nourriture et combustible produits et consommés dans la ferme même, repas ou logement gratuits, etc.
