Ottawa, December 5, 1942.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today estimates of the cash income from the sale of farm products in Canada for the period January to September, 1940 to 1942. Income by months in 1942 from the Prairie Provinces is presented in Tables 5 to 8. These estimates are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farmers for the principal farm products. The estimates are subject to revision as more complete data on production and marketings become available.

SUMMARY

Cash income from the sale of farm products in Canada during the first nine months of 1942 totalled \$671.4 million, compared with \$590.9 million in the corresponding period of 1941. This represents an increase of 13.6 per cent over 1941 and one of 37.7 per cent over the corresponding period of 1940. Cash income was higher in all provinces except Saskatchewan where the income from wheat was sharply lower than during the same period of 1941. The greatest increase in the first three quarters of 1942 occurred in the provinces of Ontario, although substantial increases were also reported for Quebec, the Maritimes and British Columbia.

Cash income to farmers from the sale of live stock and live stock products amounted to \$476.0 million during the first nine months of 1942 compared with \$369.3 in the corresponding period of 1941. Income from the sale of dairy products increased most sharply with a gain of \$44.4 million, while the income from the sale of hogs increased by \$29.8 million.

A further increase over 1941 appears likely during the fourth quarter of 1942. Owing to the late harvest in western Canada, grain marketing was delayed but from August 1 to the end of November marketings of oats, barley and flaxseed were sharply higher than during the same period a year previously. While wheat marketings were still below those of a year ago, current farm deliveries have been relatively heavy. The usual fall increase in marketings of hogs was also delayed this year but recent figures indicate that the expected increase will be forthcoming.

Income to farmers in the form of Government subsidies and bonus payments are not included in these calculations except in those cases where the assistance has resulted in higher prices to the producers.

LAND ACQUISITION REPORT  
FOR THE YEAR 1961

This report contains information regarding the acquisition of land for the Bureau of Land Management during the year 1961. The information is presented in the form of a summary of the acquisition program, a list of the lands acquired, and a description of the lands acquired.

The acquisition program for 1961 was designed to acquire land for the Bureau of Land Management in order to provide for the management of the public lands. The program was carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Federal Land Acquisition Act of 1954.

The lands acquired during the year 1961 were located in the following States: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Utah, and Wyoming.

The lands acquired during the year 1961 were acquired by the following methods: purchase, donation, and exchange. The total area of land acquired during the year 1961 was 1,234,567 acres.

The lands acquired during the year 1961 were acquired for the following purposes: for the management of the public lands, for the establishment of national monuments, and for the establishment of national parks.
