Ottawa, February 20, 1947. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today a report containing estimates of farm cash income from the sale of farm products and from supplementary payments for the calendar years 1944 to 1946.

CASH INCOME FROM THE SALE OF FARM PRODUCTS

Canadian farmers received a cash income of \$1,742.3 million from the sale of farm products in 1946 as compared with a revised estimate of 1945 receipts totalling \$1,697.7 million from the same sources. This represents a gain of \$44.6 million or 2.6 per cent. The 1946 income is \$86.2 million less than that received in the highest year recorded, 1944, when receipts totalled \$1,828.5 million. Including supplementary payments, (payments made under the Wheat Acreage Reduction Act, the Prairie Farm Assistance Act and the Prairie Farm Income Act) cash receipts in 1946 amounted to \$1,759.3 million representing a gain of \$55.2 million over the total for 1945.

Cash receipts from sales of grains, seeds and hay show an increase of \$15.9 million in 1946. This is a result of payments on wheat participation certificates for preceding crop years amounting to \$33.3 million. Gains are also recorded for 1946 in receipts from fruits, vegetables and special crops. On the other hand these increases in receipts are considerably offset by a decline in cash income from the sale of live stock due to a much lower volume of hog marketings. Cash income from the sale of farm products is higher in 1946 in all provinces with the exceptions of New Brunswick, Saskatchewan and Alberta. The decline in New Brunswick is accounted for in large part by lower income from potatoes and live stock. In Saskatchewan and Alberta lower marketings of grain and live stock are responsible for decreases below the 1945 incomes.

The estimates contained herein are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farmers for principal farm products and are subject to revision as more complete data become available. The estimates include the amounts paid on account of wheat participation certificates, the oats and barley equalization payments and those Dominion and Provincial Government payments which farmers receive as subsidies to prices. Payments made under The Wheat Acreage Reduction Act, The Prairie Farm Assistance Act and The Prairie Farm Income Act are not included with cash income from the sale of farm products but are included in the totals in the year in which payment is made under the heading "Supplementary Payments."
