

Ottawa, <u>September 3</u>, <u>1947</u>: The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today a report containing estimates of farm cash income from the sale of farm products and from supplementary payments for the first six months of 1947 together with estimates for the corresponding periods of 1945 and 1946. The estimates are given for each province by months as well as for the six-month period by commodities.

CASH INCOME FROM THE SALE OF FARM PRODUCTS

During the first six months of 1947, the cash income received by Canadian farmers from the sale of farm products and from supplementary payments amounted to \$753.9 million as against \$731.0 million and \$647.1 million for the corresponding periods in 1945 and 1946 respectively. The increase in this year's semiannual cash income estimate is a reversal of the downward trend which has been in evidence since the record year of 1944 when the cash income from January to June amounted to approximately \$766.0 million. This year's increase represents a gain of nearly 17 per cent over the first six months' cash income for 1946.

Cash income from the sale of grains and other field crops estimated at \$215 million for the first half of 1947 was more than 40 per cent above the \$150.0 million realized during the same period a year earlier. This substantial increase is largely attributable to generally higher prices for grains and larger marketings of wheat and barley in western Canada. The inclusion of the Wheat Adjusting Payments Drafts relative to the 10 cent retroactive payment on the 1945 crop made since January 1, 1947 account for the significant increase in the amount appearing under Theat Participation Certificates. Cash income of \$464.0 million from the sale of livestock and livestock products which accounts for about 60 per cent of the total cash income so far this year, is approximately 8 per cent above the cash income from this source during the January to June period of 1946. Reduced income from the sale of cattle, calves, sheep and lambs is more than offset by cash income increases from the sale of hogs, dairy products, poultry and eggs.

Although it is anticipated that total cash income for the entire 1947 season will exceed that of 1946, some tapering off of cash receipts is expected during the latter half of the current year. This assumption is based on the estimated general decrease in the production of 1947 field crops due to extremely unfavourable weather conditions which prevailed during the seeding season in eastern Canada and the critical growing period in the Prairies.

These estimates are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farmers for the principal farm products and are subject to revision as more complete data become available. The estimates include the amounts paid on account of wheat participation certificates, the cats and barley equalization payments and those Dominion and Provincial Government payments which farmers receive as subsidies to prices. Payments made under The Wheat Acreage Reduction Act, The Prairie Farm Assistance Act and The Prairie Farm Income Act are not included with cash income from the sale of farm products but are included in the totals in the year in which payment is made under the heading Supplementary Payments. These Supplementary Payments are gross payments and are subject to reduction through the refunding of overpayments.
