OTTAWA, June 25, 1948 - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues to-day a report containing estimates of farm cash income from the sale of farm products and from supplementary payments for the months of January to March 1946, 1947 and 1948. Those estimates are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farmers for the principal farm products. The estimates are subject to revision as more complete data become available.

## CASH INCOME FROM THE SALE OF FARM PRODUCTS

A preliminary estimate indicates that during the first three months of 1948 Canadian farmers realized a cash return from the sale of farm products of approximately \$403,340,000. This amount compares with cash returns from the sale of farm products of \$297,723,000 and \$339,778,000 during the corresponding periods of 1946 and 1947 respectively. With the inclusion of supplementary cash payments (i.e. cash payments made under the provisions of the Prairie Farm Assistance Act in 1946, 1947 and 1948; the Wheat Acreage Reduction Act in 1946 and 1947 and the Prairie Farm Income Act in 1946) cash receipts during the first quarter of 1948 amounted to \$418,075,000 as against \$349,295,000 for the same period a year ago and \$313,268,000 in 1946.

Compared with a year ago, cash income from the sale of field crops at \$111,817,000 for the period January to March 1948 was down 21,4 per cent. This decrease can be attributed in large part to reduced marketings of wheat and coarse grains in the Prairie Provinces which more than offset increased prices for coarse grains this year as against last. In addition wheat participation payments at slightly more than \$6,000,000 this year were more than \$9,000,000 below total payments for the first three months of 1947. The most important factor in bringing about a higher total cash income in 1948 was the very substantial gain in the receipts from the sale of livestock and livestock products. Estimated receipts from the sale of hogs at \$102,000,000 in 1948 were more than double the cash returns from this source a year ago and constituted the most important single item contributing to the sharp increase in the returns from livestock and livestock products so far this year. Gains in cash receipts were also established for the sale of dairy products, poultry and eggs.

Sains in the each income from the sale of farm products this year were evident in all provinces except Manitoba and Saskatchewan. The losses sustained in these provinces were due largely to a substantial reduction in the returns realized from the sale of grains.
