In 1944 the Dominion Bureau of Statistics issued estimates of Net Farm Income, Canada, 1940 to 1943. The present publication contains revisions of the 1940 to 1943 estimates and extends the series to cover the period 1938 to 1945. The title has been changed to Net Income of Farm Operators from Farming Operations, a title which describes the estimates more explicitly.

NET INCOME OF FARM OPERATORS FROM FARMING OPERATIONS

During the period 1938 to 1945 the net income of farm operators from farming operations increased remarkably. The net income for the last four of these eight years was more than double the income received during the first four years. The high point was reached in 1944 when farm operators received a net income of \$1,228 million as compared with \$387 million received in 1938. The increase is the result not only of substantially higher prices for farm products but also as the result of a greater volume of production together with lower relative increases in operating costs. The net income of farm operators from farming operations for 1945 was approximately \$223 million less than the net income for 1944. The decrease took place chiefly in the Prairie Provinces where smaller crops brought about substantial reductions in the cash income received from the sale of farm products.

Cash income from the sale of farm products in Canada rose consistently from \$664 million in 1938 to a peak of \$1,826 million in 1944 as the result of greatly expanded farm production and a steadily rising demand. In order to attribute the income to the year in which it was earned, the estimates take into account the values of any changes in inventory of livestock and grains from one year to the next. This results in the gross and net incomes of 1942, for example, showing up more favourably than the cash income indicates, since the heavy sales of the 1942 crop made during 1943 are credited back to the year 1942.

The value of income in kind consumed by persons on farms increased from \$185 million in 1938 to \$286 million in 1945. This increase, though due in large part to an increase in prices, is also due to increases in the consumption of homegrown produce notably meat, eggs, and milk.

As is to be expected with increased production, farm operating expenses and depreciation charges also increased during the period. Farm expenses, however, increased much less rapidly than gross income with the result that there were gains in the net income of relatively larger proportions. Operating expenses went up about 51 per cent between 1938 and 1945, and while gross income including supplementary payments increased by 98 per cent, net income ross nearly 180 per cent.

Substantial increases in total expenditures by farmers occurred particularly in the following: feed and seed, wages, fuel and oil, net farm rent and repair items. On the other hand a marked decrease in total interest payments occurred as the result of generally favourable economic conditions which enabled farmers to liquidate substantial amounts of their outstanding indebtedness.

The improvement in net income during the period 1938 to 1945 was general across Canada and was substantial in all provinces except Nova Scotia. The increases in the Prairie Provinces had largely occurred by 1942 as the result of particularly favourable crops that year. In 1943 yields in the Prairies were less favourable, but in 1944 with high production and increased prices the net income of farm operators in Manitoba and Saskatchewan reached record heights. All three Prairie Provinces returned to considerably lower income levels in 1945 when more nearly normal production was obtained. Income was maintained well above the level of the years prior to 1942, however, because of substantially higher average prices in 1945. Less spectacular but more consistently maintained income increases occurred in Prince Edward Island, Ontario and British Columbia. Farm operators in these provinces obtained their largest net incomes in 1945. In the case of Nova Scotia and New Brunswick farm operators arrived at their highest net incomes in 1943 while the high point for Quebec was 1944.

DEFINITIONS

The estimates attempt to determine the net income accruing to farm operators and their families from their own farming operations. They represent payments for the managerial services of the operator, the labour of himself and his family, together with interest on the capital invested in farm land, buildings, livestock and equipment.

The first step in calculating the net income of farm operators from farming operations is the calculation of gross income. Gross income is derived by adding to cash income from the sale of farm products the following:

- Income in kind including all produce which was grown on farms and consumed in the farm homes, together with an imputed value for house rent.
- 2. The value of positive or negative changes in inventory of grains and other farm products.

Operating expenses and depreciation charges are then deducted from gross farm income. When supplementary payments are added, the net income of farm operators from farming operations is obtained.

Net income of farm operators from farming operations does not represent the total net income accruing to persons on farms in that it does not include estimates of non-farm income received by farmers nor does it even include all income arising in agriculture in that estimates of net farm rent and interest payments on farm indebtedness, which may be received by persons on farms, are not included. As well it does not include the income of farm labourers who may be permanently domiciled on the farm, but it is as defined the net income to farm operators and their families from their own farming operations.

Total net income of farm operators is the amount which would be available to farm operators for living expenses, for the payment of income taxes, and for investment in the farm enterprise or in other investment outlets. To obtain their total net income, we would have to add to net income of farm operators from farming operations the amount farm operators receive under the following items:

- 1. Net rent of rented property (farm and non-farm)
- 2. Dividends and interest on investments
- 3. Net income from other activities such as fishing, trapping, lumbering, road work or other outside labour.

The amounts received from these sources are not available for farm operators separately at the present time.

The estimates of cash income are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farmers for the principal farm products. They include the amounts paid on account of wheat participation certificates, the cats and barley equalization payments and those Dominion and Provincial government payments which farmers receive as subsidies to prices. Included in income in kind are the products consumed on the farms on which they were produced, valued at their alternative market price (prices received by farmers), plus an imputed value for house rent. In compiling farm operating expenditures, all subsidy payments were taken into account. Thus the estimates of expenditures include only the amounts which were actually paid by farmers. Supplementary payments comprise the amounts received by farm operators in the Prairie Provinces under The Prairie Farm Assistance Act,

The Prairie Farm Income Act and The Wheat Acreage Reduction Act. The amounts paid under each program are included in the year in which they were earned.
