

NET INCOME OF FARM OPERATORS FROM FARMING OPERATIONS, 1968(1)

This report presents, by commodity and by province, estimates of net income of farm operators from farming operations for the calendar year 1968, and revised estimates for the years 1960 to 1967 (See below). As a result of more up-to-date information becoming available in recent weeks, the estimates contained in this report for 1968 differ slightly from those contained in the advance preliminary report published in May. In addition to estimates of farm net income, this report includes detailed information concerning income in kind, farm operating expenses, and depreciation charges. Commodity details for farm cash receipts from farming operations are presented in the Bureau report, Farm Cash Receipts, 1968, Catalogue No. 21-001.

Farm Net Income Concepts. — Two different estimates of farm net income from farming operations are prepared for inclusion in this report. One is called realized net income and is obtained by adding together farm cash receipts from farming operations, supplementary payments and the value of income in kind, and deducting farm operating expenses and depreciation charges. This estimate of farm net income represents the amount of income from farming that operators have left for family living, personal taxes and investment after provision has been made for operating expenses and depreciation charges. The second estimate is referred to as total net income and is obtained by adjusting realized net income to take into account changes occurring in inventories of livestock and stocks of grains on farms between the beginning and end of the year. This latter estimate is used in calculating the contribution of agriculture to National Income(2) and for making comparisons with net income of non-farm business enterprises.

Realized Farm Net Income. — For the year 1968, it is estimated that realized net income of farm operators from farming operations amounted to \$1,591.7 million. This is 3.5 per cent below the 1967 estimate of \$1,649.2 million and 8.7 per cent below the record high of \$1,742.5 million in 1966 but 6.0 per cent above the average of \$1,501.3 million for the five-year period 1963-67. Compared with a year earlier, higher 1968 estimates of farm cash receipts, income in kind, and supplementary payments were more than offset by increased operating expenses and depreciation charges.

Total Farm Net Income. — This estimate of farm income, which takes into account changes in farm inventories of field crops, livestock and poultry, amounted to \$1,796.7 million in 1968, 20.0 per cent above the estimate of \$1,496.9 million for 1967 and 14.8 per cent above the average of \$1,564.9 million for the five year period 1963-67, but 7.8 per cent below the record high level of \$1,947.7 million in 1966. Between 1967 and 1968, higher cash receipts, income in kind, supplementary payments and a substantial gain in farm inventories of field crops more than offset increased operating expenses and smaller numbers of livestock on farms at the end of the year.

Farm Cash Receipts. — Total cash receipts from farming operations for Canada amounted to \$4,385.4 million in 1968, fractionally above the record high of \$4,379.7 million in 1967 and 14.6 per cent above the average for the five years 1963-67. Maintenance of cash receipts at this level was due for the most part to higher total returns from cattle, dairy products (including supplementary payments), eggs, potatoes, larger cash advances on farm-stored grains, and greater total Canadian Wheat Board participation payments. Lower cash returns were realized from the sale of tobacco and western oilseeds, and smaller total initial receipts obtained from wheat and barley at time of delivery.

Supplementary Payments. — In addition to the above farm cash receipts, farmers also received supplementary payments amounting to about \$8.0 million in 1968 as against \$6.1 million in 1967. These payments include those made under the Prairie Farm Assistance Act and other government assistance to farmers who suffered losses as a result of adverse weather conditions.

Income in Kind. — This item represents the value of consumption of home-grown food, wool and woodlot products, plus an imputed rental value of farm dwellings. The farm products consumed are valued at the price the farmer would have received had they been sold. The value of this income component rose from \$480.3 million in 1967 to \$536.8 million in 1968. This increase can be attributed almost entirely to an increase in the estimate of the imputed rental value of farm homes. Slight gains were also recorded for fruits and vegetables.

Value of Inventory Change. — The value of inventory change is obtained by calculating the change in the quantity of field crops and the number of livestock and poultry on farms between the beginning and end of the year and valuing the differences at average annual prices. The value of total inventory change at the end of 1968 was \$205.0 million as against minus \$152.3 million in 1967. This gain in the value of inventory change between 1967 and 1968 is due largely to the substantial increase in grain production in the Prairie Provinces in 1968. Lesser gains were also recorded for year-end farm stocks of other field crops as well as poultry numbers. These gains were only partially offset by a reduction in the numbers of all classes of livestock between the end of 1967 and the end of 1968.

Farm Operating Expenses and Depreciation Charges. — This estimate includes farm business costs incurred by farmers regardless of whether they are paid for in cash or accumulated as new debt. As far as possible, they exclude outlays for goods and services obtained directly from other farmers. All subsidy payments are taken into account so that the estimates represent only the net amounts paid by farmers.

During 1968, total operating expenses and depreciation charges reached a new high level of \$3,338.4 million, 3.8 per cent above the 1967 level of \$3,216.9 million. Farmers' outlays were higher for all expenditure items except feed, repairs to buildings and other livestock expenses such as purchases of western feeder cattle. The greatest percentage increase in outlay for any single expenditure item was estimated for fertilizer and lime; the 1968 estimate of \$212.5 million was 10.4 per cent above the 1967 figure of \$192.5 million as a result of purchases of larger quantities at generally higher prices. Estimates of gross farm rents were up by more than 8 per cent with most of the increase occurring in Saskatchewan and Alberta where larger grain crops in 1968 are reflected in increased share rental payments. Although no significant changes appeared to have taken place in the size of the hired farm labour force in 1968, wage rates rose to new high levels. Total interest payments increased still further as farmers continued to expand their use of capital at higher rates of interest. Higher prices for petroleum products and greater outlay for repairs are reflected in an increase in the cost of operating farm machinery of nearly 4 per cent. In 1968, preliminary estimates indicate that mainly as a result of price declines farmers reduced their outlay for feeds purchased through commercial channels for the first time in several years. Depreciation charges on farm buildings and machinery were also higher in 1968. These charges are intended to reflect the amount that farmers would have to pay to accommodate the decline in the value of farm buildings and machinery due to obsolescence and wear.

Revisions of Estimates of Farm Net Income, 1960-67. — Estimates of farm net income from farming operations have now been revised for the years 1960 to 1967 inclusive to include bench-mark data obtained from the 1966 Census of Agriculture and the most up-to-date information from private and Government sources. The results of these revisions are set forth in this report in detail by province for each of these years for each component except farm cash receipts. Revised detailed data for estimates of farm cash receipts for this period are presented in the Bureau report, *Farm Cash Receipts*, 1968, Catalogue No. 21-001.


