## ChSH INCONE FROH THE SAIE OF FAZ: PRODUCTS IN THX PRATRIE PROVJNCES

## JATUARY TO SHETETBR, 1926 TO 1941

Ottawa, November 24, 1941.- The Dorinion Bureau of Statistics issues today estimates of the cash income from the sãle of farm products in the rairie Provinces for the months of January to Septenber, 1926 to 1941. These estimates are based on reports of marketings and prices received by farme sor the principal farm products. The estimetes are subject to revision as more complete data on production and marketings become available.

## SUMTARY

Cash income from the sale of farm products in the Prairie Provinmos Furtre the first nine months of 1941 totalled $2255,559,000$ compared with $208,588,000$ in the corresponding period of 1940 and an average of $\$ 205,192,000$ for the five years 1936 to 1940. Higher receipts in 1941 have been rocorded for all individual items contributing to the total. The higher returns from wheat occurred varly in the year as a result of the heavy marketings of the 1940 wheat crop during the first six months of 1941. Receipts from the 1941 wheat crop in the third quarter of the year are sharply below those of the sane months of 1940 but receipts from all other grains and all classes of live stock are hifher for the curront year. The inportant increases which occurred in income from the sale of live stock and animal products are the result of a greater volume of production and higher prices for these products. Income from hogs anounted to $\$ 37,404,000$ during the first nine months of 1941 as compared with $\$ 25,667,000$ during the corresponding period of 1940. Receipts from the sale of mill and butterfat were $\$ 27,320,000$ durine the first nino months of 1941 as compared with $177,759,000$ in the same months of 1940 .

Cash income in the third quarter of 1941 amounted to $99,019,000$ as compared with $\$ 118,994,000$ in the same quarter of 1940 . The reduction of $140,834,000$ in receipts from wheat during this period was partially offset by increases in income from all other sources. For the first nine months of 1941 cash income in Alberta showed the greatest increase over that of the corresponding months of 1940 . In that province the increase anounted to $\pi 27,374,000$ or 38 per cent. In Saskatchewan the increase amounted to $\$ 11,210,000$ or 12 per cent. Cash income to farmers in Manitoba was higher by $\$ 8,187,000$ or 20 per cent over the first nine months of 1940 . Total cash income for the three Prairie Provinces at $\$ 39,044,000$ in September was the highest for any individual month during the current year.

Since deliveries of whoat during the last three months of 1941 will be substantially below those of the same period a year proviously, the cash income fron wheat during the final quarter of 1941 will be considerably below that of 1940 especially in Alberta and Saskatchewan. On the other hand, income from the sale of cther grains, live stock and live-stock products will be higher. On balance cash income from the sale of fam products in the Prairie Provinces should be substantially hieher for the calendar yoar 1941 than was the case in 1940. Income included in this report is that received from the sale of famm products and does not include any bonus paynents made to farmers during the period under review.
