WEEKLY CROP REPORTS

Ottawa, June 14, 1930. To meet the demands for information on the western wheat crop which center on the months of June, July, and August, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics has decided to issue seven further telegraphic crop reports on the following dates:

June 19 June 26 July 10 July 24 July 30 August 11 August 27

These reports will be based on night letters received from a carefully selected list of federal and provincial agriculturists well distributed over the graingrowing area of western Canada. Two of the reports (July 10 and August 11) appear on the dates of condition reports as of the 31st of the preceding month and are intended to supplement the earlier numerical data.

The complete crop-reporting program for the period up to August 31st, is as follows:-
