Beginning on May 30 for the Prairie Provinces and on June 13 for the whole of Canada, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics will release a series of weekly telegraphic reports on crop conditions. In the following pages are listed the correspondents whose co-operation makes such a project possible. In general, the provincial Departments of Agriculture sends a general summary, based in most cases on telegraphic advice received from their own fieldmen scattered over the province. In addition to these reports, wires are received from the officers of the Experimental Farms and Illustration Stations systems. Intomologists and plant pathologists of the Dominion Department of Agriculture also report in connection with their special fields and officials of western companies covering hail insurance have also kindly consented to report on hail damage.

The reports for the whole of Canada will be released from Ottawa at 4 p.m. E.D.S. time on the following dates: June 13 and 27: July 11 and August 1, 15 and 29. Additional reports for the Prairie Provinces will be released at the same hour on the following dates: May 30; June 6 and 20; July 4, 18 and 25; August 9 and 22; and September 6.
