The Dominion Bureau of Statistics will release a series of weekly telegraphic reports on crop conditions in the Prairie Provinces beginning on Wednesday, May 26, and extending until Tuesday, August 31. Seven telegraphic reports for the whole of Canada will be issued at fortnightly intervals beginning on Tuesday, June 1 and extending until Tuesday, August 24.

In the following pages are listed the correspondents whose co-operation makes possible such a project. In general, the provincial Departments of Agriculture send a summary, based in most cases on telegraphic advice received from their own fieldmen scattered over the province. In addition to these reports, wires are received from the officers of the Dominion Experimental Farms and Illustration Stations systems. Entomologists and plant pathologists of the Dominion Department of Agriculture also report in connection with their special fields and officials of western companies covering hail insurance have also kindly consented to report on hail damage. Meteorological data for the Prairie Provinces are supplied by the Dominion Meteorological Service, Toronto, Ontario.
