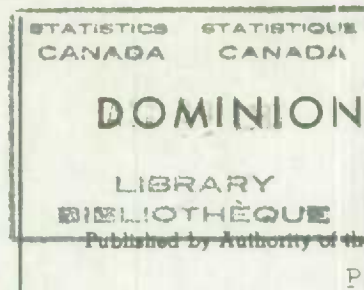


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### Crop Reporting Series - No. 2

#### Revised Estimate of Value of 1960 Field Crops; Preliminary Estimate of Value of 1961 Field Crops

Revised data indicate that the gross farm value of production of Canada's principal field crops in 1960 was \$1.7 billion, compared with \$1.6 in 1959, but well below the record \$2.35 billion of 1952. The pre-war (1935-39) average value of field crop production in Canada was \$0.58 billion, while the 1955-59 average amounted to some \$1.7 billion. Crops contributing the largest amount to the 1960 total were wheat, \$617.2 million; tame hay, \$321.5 million; oats, \$261.6 million; and barley, \$149.9 million. The gross value of the 1960 wheat crop and the all-Canada total will be increased by further payments to be made on that part of the wheat crop marketed through the Canadian Wheat Board. On a provincial basis in 1960, Saskatchewan with \$568.2 million recorded the highest value of field crop production, followed by Alberta, with \$337.6 million, and Ontario, with \$309.2 million. The gross value of field crop production in other provinces in 1960 was estimated, in millions of dollars, as follows: Manitoba, 186.3; Quebec, 178.5; British Columbia, 33.1; New Brunswick, 27.4; Prince Edward Island, 22.5; and Nova Scotia, 15.1

The preliminary estimate places the value of Canada's 1961 field crops at \$1.3 billion; considerably below the 1960 total. This estimate is based on average prices received by farmers during the August 1961-January 1962 period and on initial Canadian Wheat Board payments only for western wheat, oats and barley. The 1961 estimate reflects the low crop outturns experienced in the Prairie Provinces in 1961 but does not fully reflect the increase in market prices due to short crops. It is emphasized that a direct comparison between the 1961 preliminary total and the 1960 revised total is unrealistic. Some further payments will be made by the Canadian Wheat Board on the 1960 crop and for the 1961 crops of wheat, oats and barley in Western Canada the current estimates are based on initial payments only. The effect of additional payments on these crops, payments under the Agricultural Stabilization Act on certain other crops, as well as other adjustments through changes in price and/or production for all crops will be taken into account in later revisions when the extent of these become known.

In interpreting this report, it should be observed that the value estimates do not represent cash income received from sales but are gross values of farm production. Several crops, such as mixed grains and fodder corn, are utilized almost wholly on farms where grown and average unit farm prices determined from the relatively small quantities sold commercially. These prices are then applied to the entire production of each crop to give its estimated value. Although such crops do not add greatly to farm cash income, they increase materially the gross value of farm production of field crops. It should be noted also that when a substantial amount of a crop is carried over on farms or when inventories are being liquidated from one year to the next, average farm prices received during any particular year may not reflect exactly the value of the crop produced during the corresponding period.

Where monthly marketing data are available, the monthly average farm prices have been weighted by marketings to give weighted average unit values for the period. The average values assigned to most crops have been determined initially from reports of the Bureau's farm price correspondents, but have been accepted only after consultation with officials responsible for agricultural statistics in each of the provinces and after due consideration has been given to factors such as quality and grade. For some crops, price data have been supplied by processing companies and marketing agencies.

The interim payment on the 1960 western wheat crop and the total payments on sugar beets in the four beet-producing provinces have been included in the 1960 estimates. Details of final payments on the 1960 western wheat crop have not yet been announced. Final prices for the 1959 wheat, oats and barley crops for Western Canada are shown in Table 1, Footnote 1.

Except where noted in the tables, values per unit assigned to each crop in 1961 represent prices received by farmers from August 1, the beginning of the current crop year, up to mid-January only. No attempt has been made to forecast prices for the remainder of the crop year. For the 1961 crops of wheat, oats and barley in Western Canada the current estimates are based on initial payments only. The effect of additional payments on these crops, payments under the Agricultural Stabilization Act on certain other crops, as well as other adjustments through changes in price and/or production for all crops will be taken into account in later revisions when the extent of these become known.

For most crops, production estimates in this report are those published in the Dominion Bureau of Statistics' November Estimate of Production. Details of the estimates for which revisions have been made since the publication of the November report may be found in Table 4. Revised figures on visible (commercial) carryover stocks of the five major grains at the end of the 1960-61 crop year have been recently released by the Board of Grain Commissioners making revisions necessary in total stocks figures. These latest data on carryover stocks may be found in Table 5.
