## STOCKS OF GRAIN IN CANADA

Ottama, September 27, 1921/ The Dominion Bureau of Statistics reports the following as the stocks of grain in Canada at the close of the crop year on August 31, 1921, as compared with 1920: Wheat 13,727,088 bushels, as against 9,290,425 bushels in 1920; oats $43,960,349$ bushels, as against $9,680,917$ bushels; barley $3,849,439$ bushels, as against $1,502,430$ bushels; rye 830,550 bushels, as against 121,772 bushels; flaxseed $1,803,998$ bushels, as against 616,123 bushels/ The quantities for 1921 are made up as follows: WHEAT: In farmers' hands $2,144,400$ bushels; in elevators $4,831,175$ bushels; in transit by rail $6,031,889$ bushels, and in flour mills 719,624 bushels. OATS: In farmers' hands $29,657,300$ bushels; in elevators $12,616,110$ bushels; in transit by rail 1,336,001 bushels; in flour milis 350,938 bishels. BARLEY: In farmers' hands 1,072,900 bushels; in elevators 2,120,519 bushels; in transit by rail 628,733 birshels; in flour mills 27,287 bushels. RYE: In farmers' hands 58,500 bushels; in elevators 437,430 bushels; in transit br rail 328,922 bushelw; in flour mills 5,698 bushels. FLAXE4ED: In farmers' hands 50,700 bushels; in elevators $1, r 1,3,841$ bushels; in transit by rail 39,458 bushels.
