STOCKS OF GRAIN IN CANADA

Ottawa, August 13, 1928. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics reports the following as the stocks of grain in Canada at the close of the crop year ended July 31, 1928 as compared with the same date, last year within brackets. The quantities are expressed in Imperial bushels. WHEAT 76,4g4,052 (50,765,435); OATS 28,712,183 (23,-045,449); BARLEY 3,459,297 (5.651,547); RYE 2,084,615 (1,293,777); FLAXSEED 1,296,347 (2,056,106). The quantities for 1928 are made up as follows: WHEAT - In farmers' hands 4,136,000; in elevators 53,570,342; in transit by rail 4,642,965; in transit by water 9,084,745, in flour mills (estimated) 5,000,000. OATS - In farmers' hands 20,565,600, in elevators 5,718,751; in transit by rail 994,755; in transit by water 533,077; in flour mills 900,000. BARLEY - In farmers' hands 1,657,000; in elevators 1,366,300; in transit by rail 242,944; in transit by water 142,553; in flour mills 30,000. RTS - In farmers' hands 125,000; in elevators 1,380,132; in transit by rail 35,609; in transit by water 489,874; in flour mills 4,000. FLAXSEED - In farmers' hands 5,500; in elevators 1,117,895; in transit by rail 93,957; in transit by water 78,995. The quantities in farmers' hands are estimated from the reports of crop correspondents.
