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Field Crop Reporting Series - No. 3 STOCKS OF CANADIAN GRAIN AT MARCH 31, 1972

Total stocks of wheat, oats, barley, rye and flaxseed in all North American positions at March 31, 1972 are estimated at 1,552.5 million bushels, compared with 1,686.2 million at the same date in 1971, and the ten-year (1962-71) average of 1,357.3 million bushels. This year's March 31 stocks, in millions of bushels, with last year's totals and the ten-year averages, respectively, in brackets are estimated as follows: wheat, 864.8 (981.3, 849.3); oats, 227.2 (295.3, 242.9); barley, 411.1 (348.6, 235.7); rye, 20.4 (22.0, 12.8); and flaxseed, 29.0 (39.0, 16.6). Data for these estimates were obtained from Statistics Canada's annual March 31 survey of avain held on farms, from mill returns, and from information supplied by the Canadian Grain Commission relative to grain in commercial positions at the close of business on March 29, 1972.

Wheat and Rye. - Total stocks of Canadian wheat at March 31, 1972 are estimated at 864.8 million bushels compared with 981.3 million on the same date in 1971 and the ten-year average of 849.3 million bushels. It is estimated that 584.0 million bushels representing 68 per cent of the total were held on farms. Of the 280.8 million bushels in off-farm positions, 163.7 million were in primary elevators. Rye stocks at 20.4 million bushels were 7 per cent less that last year's 22.0 million but 59 per cent above the ten-year average of 12.8 million. Some 66 per cent of the rye stocks this year was located on farms.

Oats, Barley and Flaxseed. - March-end stocks of oats in all positions, estimated at 227.2 million bushels, were lower than last year's 295.3 million and below the ten-year average of 242.9 million bushels. Barley stocks at 411.1 million bushels were above the 1971 level of 348.6 million. Average barley stocks at March 31 for the 1962-71 period were 235.7 million bushels. Stocks of <u>flaxseed</u> at 29.0 million bushels were substantially below the 1971 level of 39.0 million bushels. Average flaxseed stocks at March 31 for the 1962-71 period were 16.6 million bushels. Farm-held stocks this year accounted for 88; 76 and 59 per cent of total stocks of

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oats, barley and flaxseed, respectively.

Farm stocks. — Total farm-held stocks (includes marketable grain and quantities held for feed, seed and reserves) of wheat, oats, barley, rye and flaxseed at March 31, 1972 are estimated at 1,126.0 million bushels compared with last year's 1,199.4 million bushels. Average farm stocks for the 1962-71 period were 883.8 million bushels. This year's March 31 farm stocks of grain in millions of bushels, with last year's totals and the ten-year averages, respectively in brackets, are estimated as follows: wheat, 584.0 (629.0, 481.6); oats, 200.0 (267.0, 210.9); barley, 311.5 (260.0, 174.6); rye, 13.4 (16.4, 8.0); and flaxseed, 17.0 (27.0, 8.7).

Rapeseed. — An estimated total of 68.4 million bushels of rapeseed was in all positions at the end of March 1972 of which 50.0 million were held on farms. Comparable data are not available for earlier years.

About 78 per cent of all farm-held stocks of oats, and 93 per cent or more of farm stocks of each of the other grains were located in the Prairie Provinces. Distribution of farm stocks at March 31, in millions of bushels, for Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, respectively, is estimated as follows: wheat, 55.0, 430.0, 90.0; oats, 35.0, 75.0, 45.0; barley, 45.0, 150.0, 95.0; rye, 1.3, 7.4, 4.3; flaxseed, 3.2, 10.7, 3.1; and rapeseed 6.5, 28.0, 15.5.

STOCKS OF CANADIAN GRAIN AT MARCH 31, 1972

The following data on stocks of Canadian grain in Canada and United States as of March 31, 1972 have been compiled by Statistics Canada and the Economics and Statistics Division, Canadian Grain Commission. Stocks of grain on farms are estimated from reports of the bureau's crop correspondents while those in mill bins are estimated from monthly returns made by mill operators to the bureau. Stocks in all other positions are those reported by the Canadian Grain Commission as visible stocks at the close of business on March 29, 1972. It should be noted that the statistics on total stocks as presented in this report differ from the weekly visible stocks figures at March 29, by the inclusion of stocks on farms and millable stocks in mill bins.
