## Patt REORT

OTTANA, November 6. 1948 - The Dominion Burcau of bitatistics in co-cperation with the Parketing Service of the Department of Agriculture and the Provincial Departments of Agriculture iscues to-day a renort on the production of fruits in Ganada as indicated by conditions on October 15.

> SUKNARY

The estimates for apples, pears and grapes have heen revised downerd since the last report. A slight upward adjustment in the estimate of the New Prunswick apple crop was more than over" come by downard revisions in Nova Scotia and Ontario, to bring the Canadian apple crop to $14,183,000 \mathrm{bu}$. compared with $14,725,000$ bu. last month. The current estimatie makes the crop 9 per cent smaller than the 1947 harvest of $15,619,000$ bu. A sharp declino in the estimate of pear production in Ontario occurrec during the last month to bring the Canadian crop to 716,000 bu. Froduction is now set at 26 per cent below the 1947 level of $966,000 \mathrm{bu}$. The grape harvest in Ontario was also disappointing. A decline of 18 per cent in that province since last month brings the Canadian total to $60,465,000 \mathrm{lt}$. The 1947 harvest amounted to $73,803,000 \mathrm{lb}$.
