FRUIT REPORT

OTTAWA, November 10, 1948 - This report replaces F. R. No. 7 published on November 6, 1948 and includes revised estimates of production in British Columbia. These revisions are based on information that was not available at the time the previous report was published.

SUMMARY

The estimates of the late fruit crops, with the exception of grapes, are further revised downward on the basis of information recently received from British Volumbia. The arrle crop is now estimated at 13,056,000 bu, making the crop 16 per cent smaller than that of last season. Pears also failed to reach the volume anticipated a month ago and are now estimated at 697,000 bu. compared with 966,000 bu. in 1947. A slight downward revision in the plum estimates brings the crop to 681,000 bu. while a further substantial decrease in the peach harvest brings the estimate to 1,497,000 bu.
