For all Provinces other than British Columbia the original estimates secured by the Bureau were stated in measures of volume. These were converted to tons at the following rates: 1 quart of strawberries or raspberries = 1.25 pounds except in British Columbia where 1 quart = 1.5 pounds. For cherries the conversion used was 1 bushel = 50 pounds.

The United States Department of Agriculture published the original estimates of strawberries in pounds; peaches and pears in bushels; apricots and cherries, sweet and sour, in tons. The following conversion rates were used to bring these items to corresponding units in the Canadian crop estimates: strawberries, 1 qt. = 1.5 lb.; peaches, 1 bu. = 48 lb.; apricots, 1 bu. = 48 lb.; pears, 1 bu. = 50 lb. except California where 1 bu. = 48 lb.; cherries, 1 bu. = 56 lb. (Conversion Factors and Weights and Measures for Agricultural Commodities and Their Products - United States Department of Agriculture, May, 1952).
