

This survey was instituted in 1964 to obtain data on Canadian mushroom production, value of crop and value of investment. The results of the 1971 survey are shown in the following tables along with revised statistics for the previous year. The figures are on a calendar year basis.

Except as indicated below the statistics are the totals of data as reported by the correspondents on the questionnaires returned to Statistics Canada. The number reporting in 1971 was 106 compared with 101 in 1970. The value and quantity of the mushroom crop in British Columbia is reported by their local marketing association.

The total mushroom production in 1971 was 32.2 million pounds an increase of 6.3 million pounds from the 1970 figure of 25.9 million pounds. The total value of the 1971 crop is estimated at 16.9 million dollars as compared with the 1970 value of 13.2 million dollars. Total area of mushroom beds in 1971 increased by 343 thousand square feet, over the 1970 figure. The total value of investment in the Canadian mushroom industry has doubled over the past seven years. The total investment in 1964 was 12.0 million dollars compared with the 1971 reported figure of 25.5 million dollars.
