#### CANADIAN MUSHROOM GROWERS SURVEY, 1972

This survey was instituted in 1964 to obtain data on Canadian mushroom production, value of crop and value of investment. The results of the 1972 survey are shown in the following tables along with revised statistics for the previous year. The figures are on a calendar year basis.

Except as indicated below the statistics are the totals of data as reported by the correspondents on the questionnaires returned to Statistics Canada. The number reporting in 1972 was 131 compared with 108 in 1971. The value and quantity of the mushroom crop in British Columbia is reported by their local marketing association.

The total mushroom production in 1972 was 40.0 million pounds an increase of 7.8 million pounds from the 1971 figure of 32.2 million pounds. The total value of the 1972 crop is estimated at 20.2 million dollars as compared with the 1971 value of 16.9 million dollars. Total area of mushroom beds in 1972 increased by 616 thousand square feet, over the 1971 figure. The total value of investment in the Canadian mushroom industry has almost tripled over the past eight years. The total investment in 1964 was 12.0 million dollars compared with the 1972 reported figure of 33.7 million dollars.




## Canadian Mushroom Production, 1964 to 1972
