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ACREAGE AND PRODUCTION OF COMMERCIAL VEGETABLES, 1959

The accompanying table comprises estimates of the acreage and production and total farm value of commercial vegetables in Canada, insofar as data are available for 1959, with revised figures for 1958. In 1958, for the first time, separate estimates of the acreage and production of beans and corn (two of the principal canning crops) were prepared for that portion produced for the fresh market and that portion grown for processing. Estimates were also prepared for cucumbers. Similarly, an attempt was made to estimate average prices received by farmers for fresh vegetables in certain provinces. In the case of vegetables grown for processing, however, final 1959 returns to farmers are not yet available, although the 1958 prices are shown in this report. It was not possible to prepare this additional information for all crops in all provinces. Therefore, in certain areas, less detail is shown than in others. It is anticipated, however, that in next year's report the detail will be expanded and comparable data will be available for all provinces in which these crops are grown.

The methods of preparing the 1959 vegetable crop estimates varied for the different areas and, to some extent, for the different crops. With the exception of Ontario and British Columbia, questionnaires were mailed to all farmers who reported growing vegetables for sale in the 1956 Census, in all provinces for which statistics are published in this report. There were two questionnaires; the first one mailed in June was designed to provide information on the acreage of vegetables and the second mailed towards the end of the year provided information on yields and prices.

In the Maritime Provinces, Quebec, Manitoba and Alberta, the results of these surveys formed the basis of the estimates with the final figures being prepared in consultation with representatives of the Federal Department of Agriculture, the Provincial Departments of Agriculture and the Quebec Bureau of Statistics. In Ontario the estimates for most crops were prepared by the Ontario Fruit and Vegetable Statistics Committee. Statistics on vegetables in British Columbia were compiled by the Provincial Department of Agriculture.

For the canning crops - asparagus, beans, corn, peas and tomatoes - acreages contracted and planted under contract and purchases of raw materials and payments for raw materials were obtained from processing firms.

The estimates printed in this report cover only vegetables grown commercially for fresh sale and for processing. Not included are any vegetables grown either on farms or elsewhere for home consumption only. The areas shown in the accompanying table are planted acreage, and yields were calculated on a planted basis. In certain cases acreage actually harvested would be somewhat less than acreage planted.
