# SHIPMENTS OF FRUIT AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERY STOCK

1953

Statistics concerning the nursery industry in Canada for the year ending June 30, 1953 are presented in the accompanying tables. All nurseries were asked to report the quantities sold of all stock which they had propagated themselves or which they had imported during this period. Stock purchased from other nurseries in Canada was excluded, to prevent duplication in reporting.

For the year ending June 30th, 1953 a total of 165 nurseries reported quantities sold in the categories described above. Numbers of nurseries reporting by provinces were as follows: Ontario 76; Quebec 40; British Columbia 25; Manitoba ten; Saskatchewan six; Alberta four and the Maritime Provinces four.

A summary of the total shipments of nursery stock is shown in Table 1. At the request of the Canadian Nurserymen's Association the value of sales was not collected for the year ending June 30, 1953. This season for the first time quantities of domestically grown stock sold were obtained separately from sales of imported stock. The results of this one year period (a summary of which appears in Table 1) indicated that imported ornamental nursery stock is much more important in relation to total sales than is imported fruit stock.

In Table 2 area in nursery stock is shown by provinces for the year ending June 30, 1953. Percentages of nursery stock reported shipped in the spring and fall by provinces of origin are shown in Table 3.
