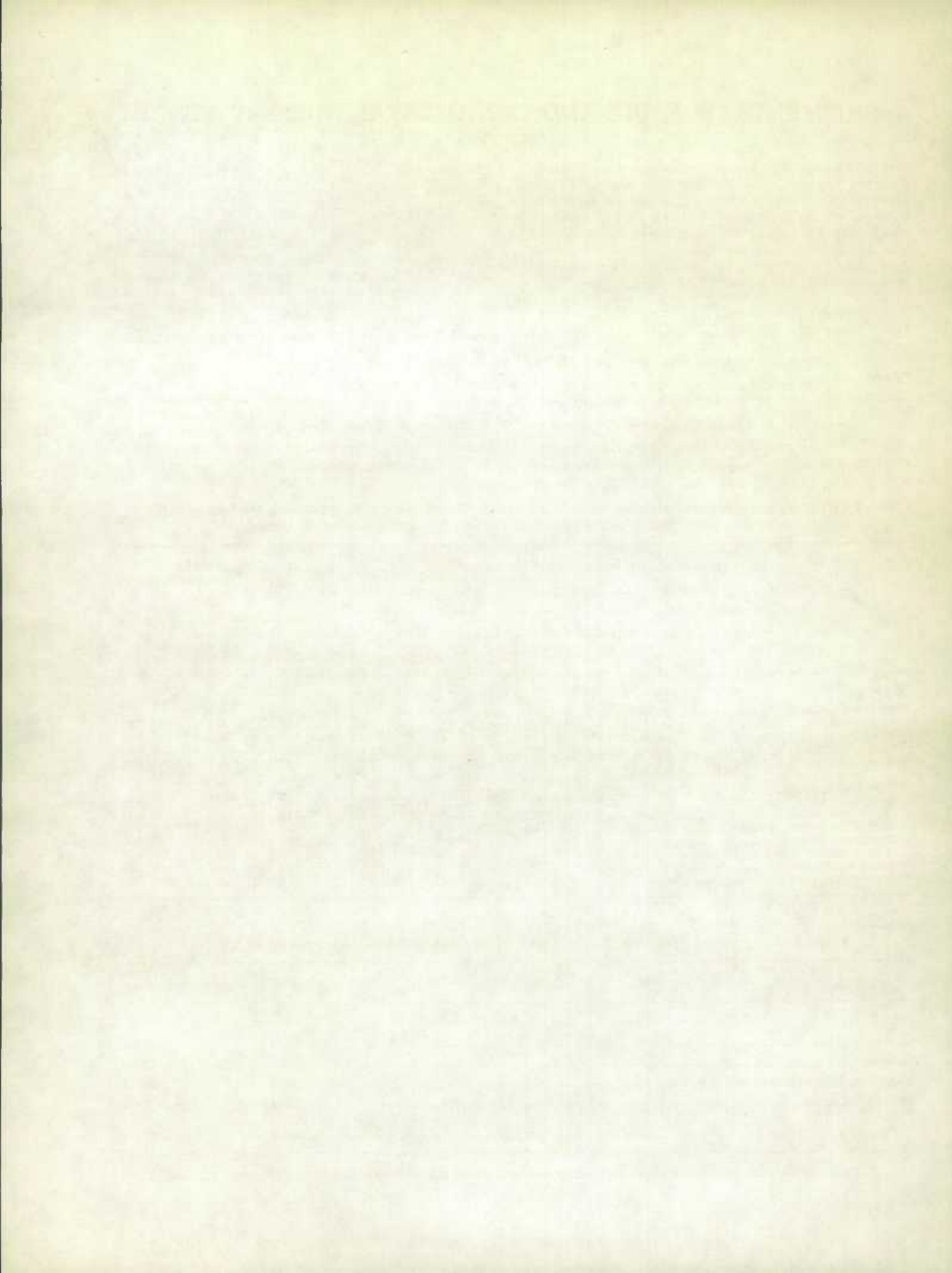

SHIPMENTS OF FRUIT AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERY STOCK 1956

Statistics concerning the nursery industry in Canada for the year ending June 30, 1956 are presented in the accompanying tables. All nurseries were asked to report the quantities sold of all stock which they had propagated themselves or which they had imported during this period. Stock purchased from other nurseries in Canada was excluded to prevent duplication in reporting.

For the year ending June 30th, 1956 a total of 127 nurseries reported quantities sold in the categories described above. Number of nurseries reporting shipments by provinces were as follows: Ontario 63, Quebec 29, British Columbia 20, Manitoba 7, Saskatchewan 2, Alberta 2 and the Maritime Provinces 4.

The total number of nurseries reporting was smaller this year than last. In 1956 a total of 127

companies submitted reports to the D.B.S. while in 1955, 155 reported.

A summary of the total shipments of nursery stock is shown in Table 1. At the request of the Canadian Nurserymen's Association the value of sales was not collected starting with the year ending June 30, 1953. For 1954 and 1955 however quantities of domestically grown stock sold were obtained separately from sales of imported stock.

In Table 2 area in nursery stock is shown by provinces for the year ending June 30, 1956. Percentages of nursery stock reported shipped in the spring and fall by provinces of origin are shown in Table 3.
