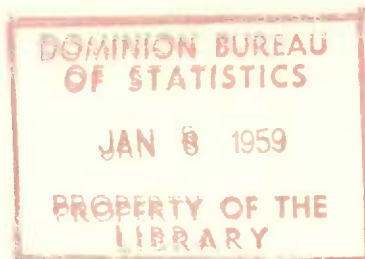

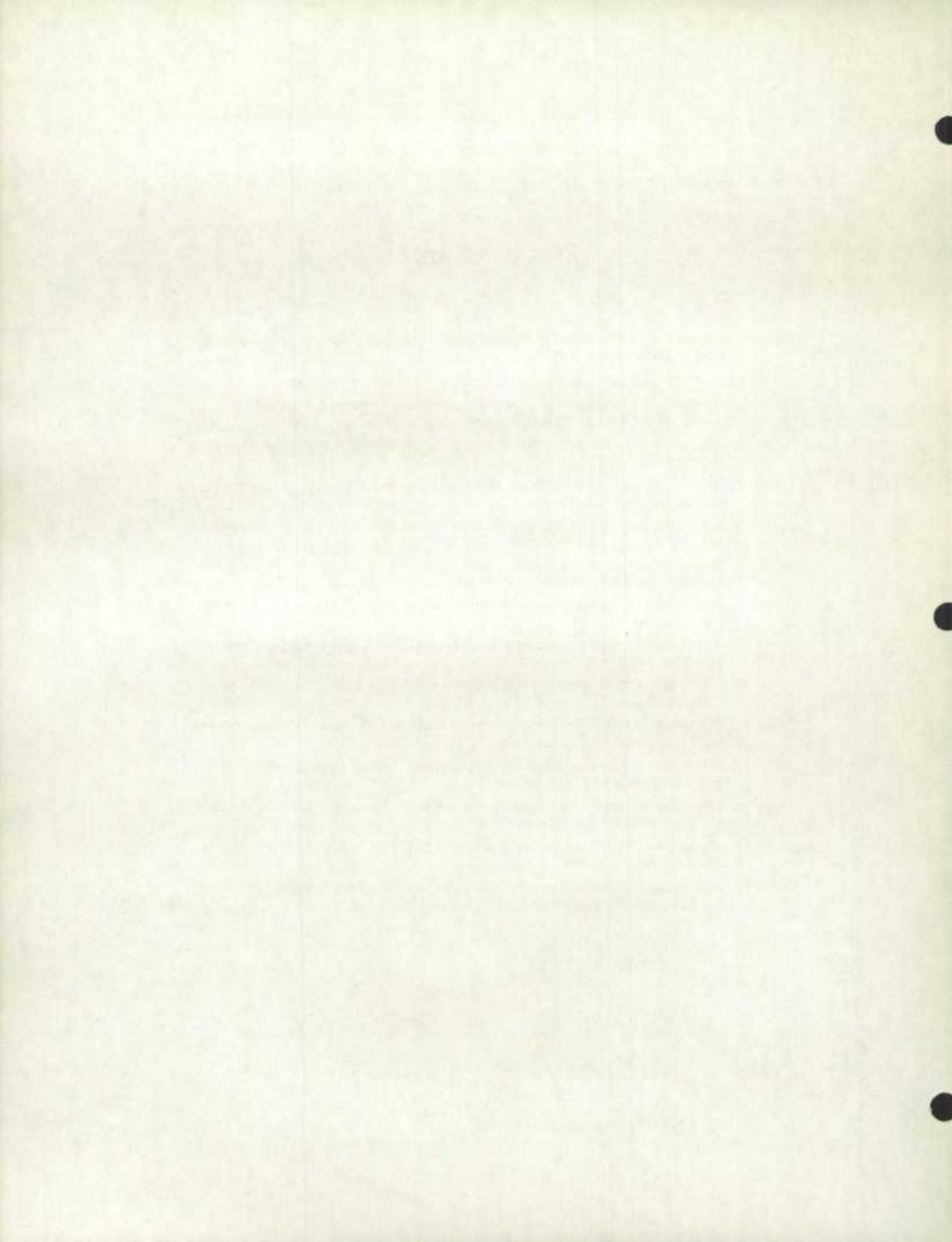

SHIPMENTS OF FRUIT AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERY STOCK

July 1, 1956 - December 31, 1957

Statistics concerning the nursery industry in Canada for the period July 1, 1956 to December 31, 1957 are presented in the accompanying tables. All nurseries were asked to report the quantities sold of all stock which they propagated themselves or which they had imported during this period. Stock purchased from other nurseries in Canada was excluded to prevent duplication in reporting.

For this period a total of 269 nurseries reported shipments in the categories described above. The number of nurseries reporting shipments by provinces were as follows: Ontario 152, Quebec 27, British Columbia 47, Manitoba 15, Saskatchewan 5, Alberta 10 and the Maritime Provinces 13.

The total number of nurseries reporting was larger this year than in 1955, when there were 155.

This increase was largely due to the addition of a number of firms to the mailing list.

A summary of the total shipments of nursery stock is shown in Table 1. In Table 2 area in nursery stock is shown by provinces for an eighteen month period ending December 31, 1957. Percentages of nursery stock reported shipped in the spring and fall by provinces of origin are shown in Table 3.

Owing to the fact that this report presents data for an eighteen month period, while previous releases refer to twelve month periods (July 1 to June 30) the statistics are not comparable and no comparisons are shown. To obtain information on nursery stock shipments for previous years, reference may be made to earlier releases of this report. It is planned to collect data in the future on a calendar year basis.
