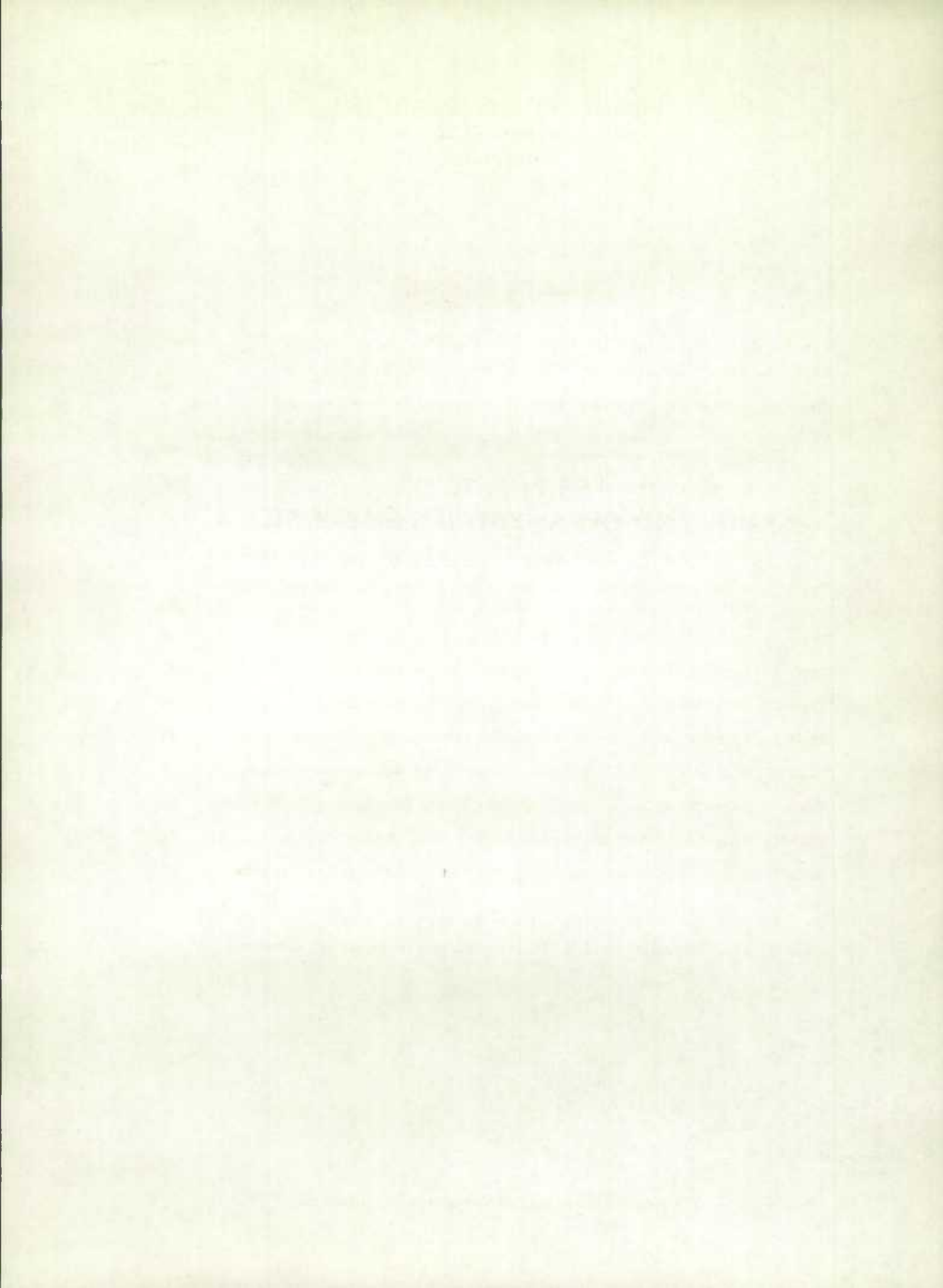

SHIPMENTS OF FRUIT AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERY STOCK 1958

Statistics concerning the nursery industry in Canada for the period January 1, 1958, to December 31, 1958, are presented in the accompanying tables. All nurseries were asked to report the quantities sold of all stock which they propagated themselves or which they had imported during this period. Stock purchased from other nurseries in Canada was excluded to prevent duplication in reporting.

A total of 279 nurseries reported shipments of the categories described above in 1958. The number of nurseries reporting shipments by province were as follows: Ontario 147; Quebec 32; British Columbia 55; Manitoba 15; Maritime Provinces 13; Alberta 10; Saskatchewan 7. This was slightly above the 1957 total of 269 reporting.

A summary of the total shipments of nursery stock is shown in Table I and in Table II the total area planted to nursery stock reported by firms sub-

mitting reports to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is indicated. A total of 224 nurseries reported sales of ornamental nursery stock but only 194 included a report on the value of products sold. Similarly, there were 180 firms with sales of fruit stock items but only 138 of them reported value figures. Table I shows the total figures reported in all cases; thus the value data do not cover all sales of nursery stock reported in the different classes in this table.

Owing to the fact that this report presents data for a twelve month period, while the previous release refers to an eighteen month period, the statistics are not comparable and no comparisons are shown. To obtain information on nursery stock shipments for previous years, reference may be made to earlier releases of this report. It is planned to continue to collect data in the future on a calendar year basis.
