# SHIPMENTS OF FRUIT AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERY STOCK 1959

Statistics concerning the nursery industry in Canada for the period January 1, 1959, to December 31, 1959, are presented in the accompanying tables. All nurseries were asked to report the quantities sold of all stock which they propagated themselves or which they had imported during this period. Stock purchased from other nurseries in Canada was excluded to prevent duplication in reporting.

A total of 443 nurseries reported shipments of the categories described above in 1959. The number of nurseries reporting shipments by province were as follows: Ontario 228; Quebec 49; British Columbia 97; Manitoba 23; Maritime Provinces 22; Alberta 14; Saskatchewan 10. In the previous year only 279

nurseries had reported. The greater number this year was due largely to additions to the mailing list.

A summary of the total shipments of nursery stock is shown in Table I and in Table II the total area planted to nursery stock reported by firms submitting reports to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is indicated. A total of 343 nurseries reported sales of ornamental nursery stock but only 273 included a report on the value of products sold. Similarly, there were 221 firms with sales of fruit stock items but only 129 of them reported value figures. Table I shows the total figures reported in all cases; thus the value data do not cover all sales of nursery stock reported in the different classes in this table

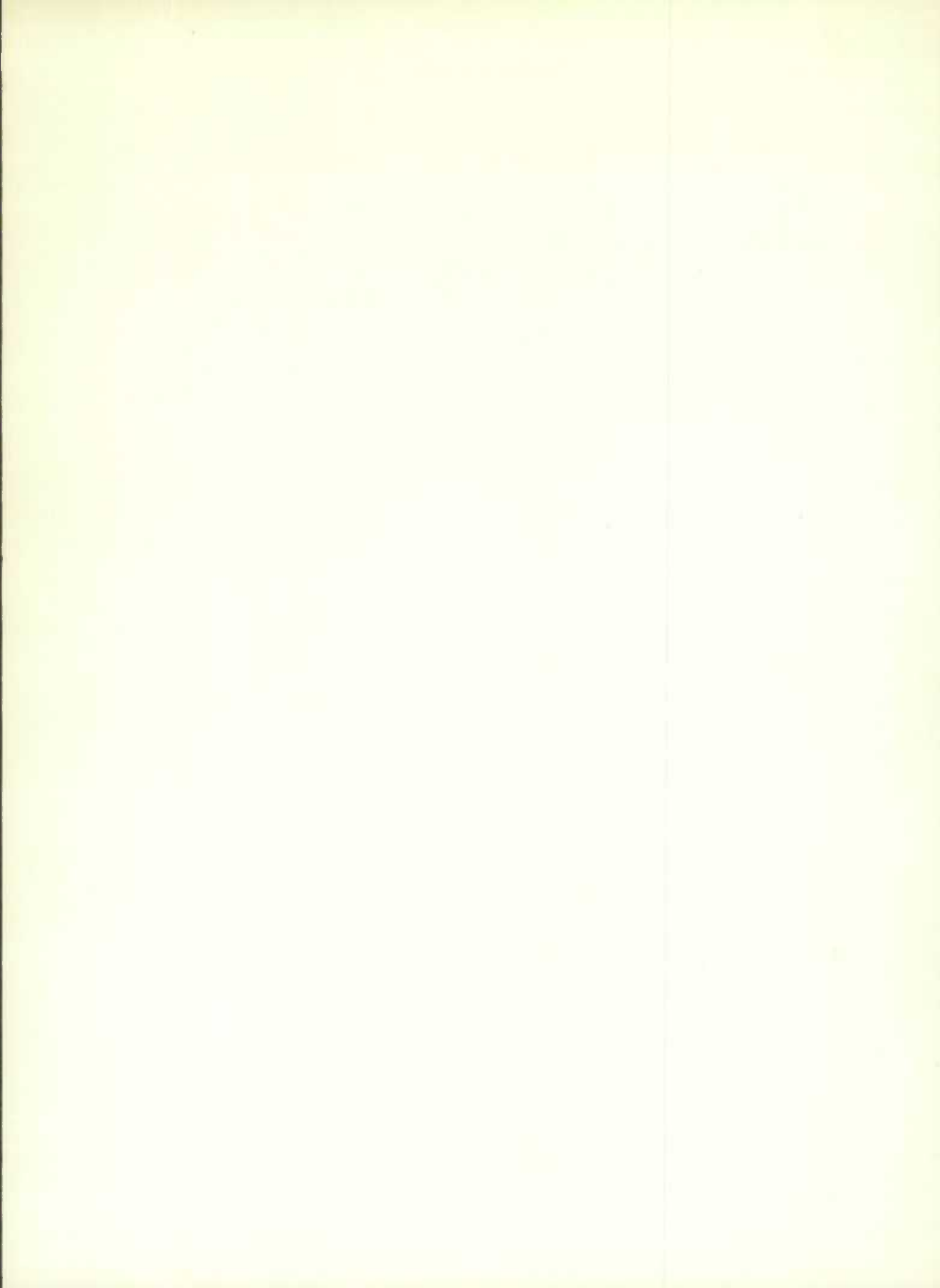

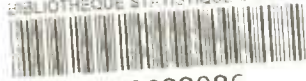
