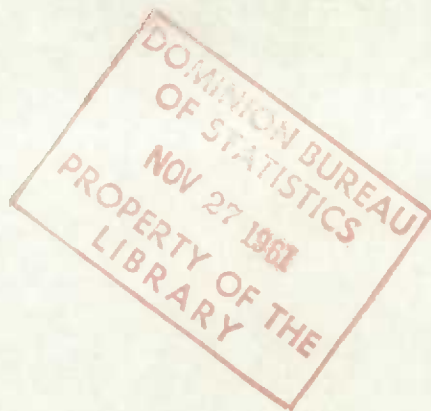

SHIPMENTS OF FRUIT AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERY STOCK 1960

Statistics concerning the nursery stock industry in Canada for the year 1960 are presented in the accompanying tables. This material was compiled from the results of the survey undertaken in 1961 in which questionnaires were sent to all nurseries in Canada asking for a report on the quantities of nursery stock sold during 1960, which the reporting nurseries had propagated themselves, or which they had grown on for 12 months or more. Nursery stock imported for immediate sale, that is for sale without further cultural treatment by the importer was not included in the scope of this survey. Stock purchased from other Canadian nurseries for immediate sale was also excluded to prevent duplication in reporting. In addition to statistics on quantities sold, information was obtained on the total value of sales of ornamental and fruit stock, acreages and the proportion of shipments made in the spring and the fall.

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics has carried out an annual survey of the nursery stock industry in Canada for some years. The data collected for the year 1960, however, were somewhat different from those obtained in previous years. The changes instituted were undertaken at the request of the Canadian Nurserymen's Association. Not only were data on sales of imported nursery stock not collected during 1960 but information on imported lining-out stock for the use of the importer was also omitted. In addition somewhat less detail on sales by varieties was requested and the section on herbaceous perennials was dropped. As the result of these changes the figures contained in this report are not entirely comparable to those published for the previous year. For this reason 1959 data are not shown in this report.

A total of 336 nurseries reported sales of nursery stock in the categories described above in 1960. The number of nurseries reporting sales by province were as follows: Ontario 183; Quebec 43; British Columbia 54; Manitoba 23; Maritime Provinces 13; Alberta 11; Saskatchewan 9.

A summary of the total sales of nursery stock is shown in Table I and in Table II the total area planted to nursery stock reported by firms submitting reports to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is indicated. A total of 286 nurseries reported sales of ornamental nursery stock but only 242 included a report on the value of products sold. Similarly, there were 185 firms with sales of fruit stock items but only 166 of them reported value figures. Table I shows the total figures reported in all cases; thus the value data do not cover all sales of nursery stock reported in the different classes in this table.
