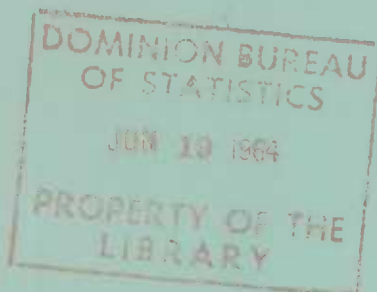

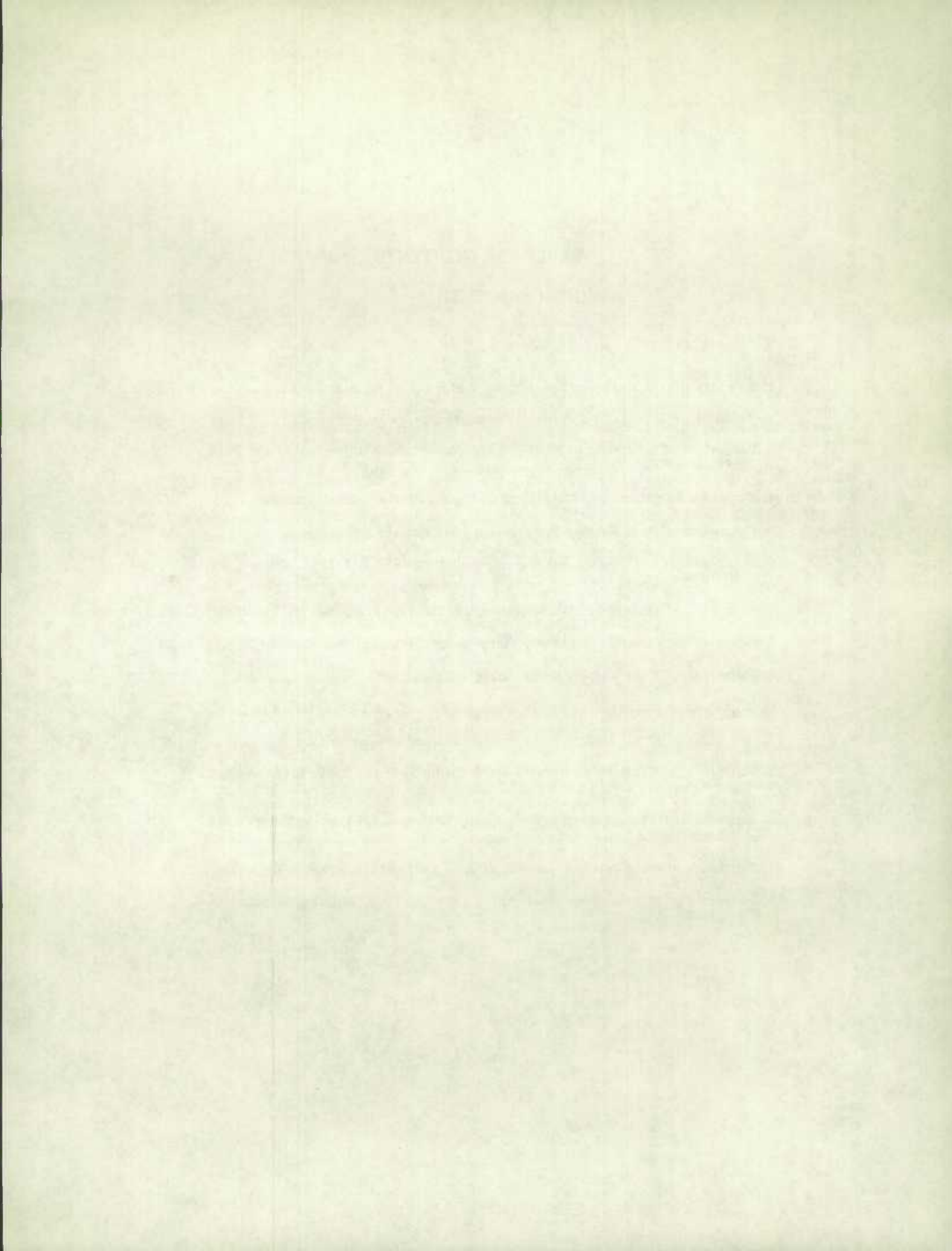

INTRODUCTION

Statistics concerning the nursery stock industry in Canada for the year 1962 are presented in the accompanying tables. This material was compiled from the results of a survey undertaken in 1963 in which questionnaires were sent to all nurseries in Canada asking for a report on the quantities of nursery stock sold during 1962 which the reporting nurseries had propagated themselves, or which they had grown on for 12 months or more. Nursery stock imported for immediate sale, that is for sale without further cultural treatment by the importer was not included in the scope of this survey. Stock purchased from other Canadian nurseries for immediate sales was also excluded to prevent duplication in reporting. In addition to statistics on quantities sold, information was obtained on the total value of sales at wholesale or ornamental and fruit stock, acreages and the proportion of shipments made in the spring and the fall.

A total of 251 nurseries reported sales of nursery stock in the categories described above in 1962. The number of nurseries reporting sales by province were as follows: Ontario 142; Quebec 30; British Columbia 40; Manitoba 12; Maritime Provinces 12; Alberta 11; Saskatchewan 4. In 1961, 299 nurseries were reported with 169 in Ontario, 37 in Quebec, 47 in British Columbia, 14 in Manitoba, 13 in the Maritimes, 11 in Alberta and 8 in Saskatchewan.

A summary of the total sales of nursery stock is shown in Table 1 and in Table 2 the total area planted to nursery stock reported by firms submitting reports to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is indicated. A total of 186 nurseries reported sales of ornamental nursery stock; 185 included a report on the value of products sold. Similarly, there were 141 firms with sales of fruit stock items but only 112 of them reported value figures. Table 1 shows the total figures reported in all cases; thus the value data do not cover all sales of nursery stock reported in the different classes in this table. In 1961, 229 firms reported value of ornamental sales and 139 value of fruit stock sold. There was thus a substantial reduction in the number of firms reporting sales in 1962 from 1961 but in spite of this, the total sales figures reported for 1962 were higher than for the previous year.
