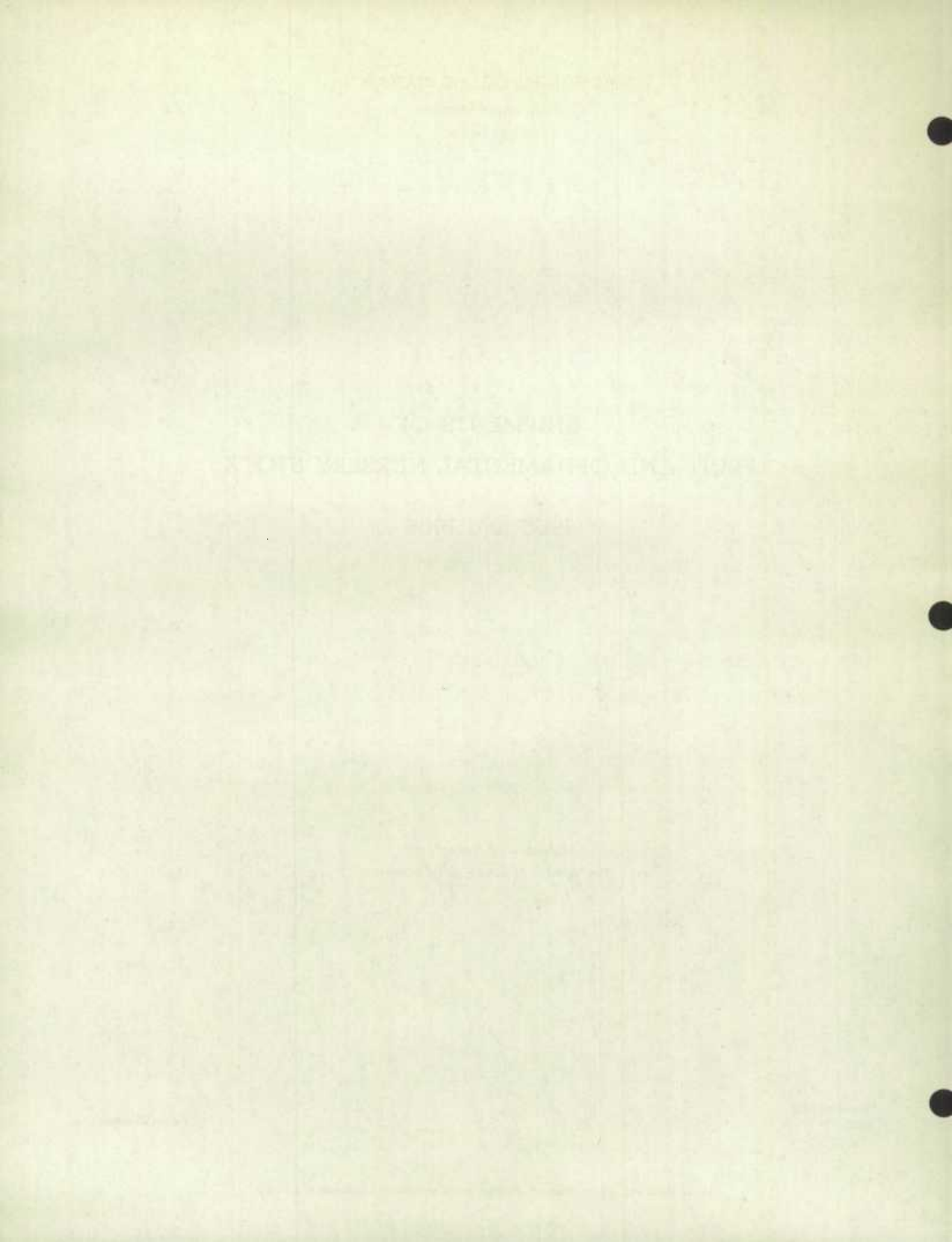

## INTRODUCTION

Statistics concerning the nursery stock industry in Canada for the years 1965 and 1966 are presented in the accompanying tables. This material was compiled from the results of surveys undertaken in 1966 and 1967 in which questionnaires were sent to all nurseries in Canada asking for a report on the sales of nursery stock sold during 1965 and 1966 which the nurseries had propagated themselves, or grown on for twelve months or more.

The 1965 and 1966 questionnaires were changed some, from that employed in previous years, at the request of the Canadian Nursery Trades Association; as the patterns of demand change corresponding changes are necessary from time to time in the coverage of material for which reports are requested. In addition, a section was added in 1965 and 1966 asking for information on purchases of nursery stock for growing on, and for sales during the current season; both from domestic sources and from vendors in other countries. Information was also requested on the pattern of sales, that is, the total value of stock sold at retail, that sold to landscape contractors, sales to other nurseries, and finally, sales to other retailers. Also, information was requested on the value of allied continuities of landscape contracts.

Although questionnaires were sent to all nurseries it is not possible to get replies from every operator, however, it is believed that with very few exceptions, reports have been received

from all major nurseries, and accordingly, the bulk of the industry is thought to be covered in the reports submitted.

A total of 257 nurseries reported sales of nursery stock in the categories described above for 1966 while in 1965 only 209 reported. The number of nurseries reporting sales by provinces in 1966 were as follows: Ontario 122, Quebec 34, British Columbia 56, Manitoba 13, Maritimes 15, Alberta and Saskatchewan 17. In 1965, there were 119 nurseries reporting in Ontario, 23 in Quebec, 32 in British Columbia, 9 in Manitoba, 12 in the Maritimes, and 14 in Saskatchewan and Alberta. As a result of this variation in the number reporting, statistics for 1966 are not entirely comparable with those of 1965.

A summary of the total sales of nursery stock is shown in Table 1 and in Table 2 the total area planted to nursery stock reported by firms submitting reports to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is indicated. In 1966, with last year's figures in brackets, a total of 218 (177) nurseries reported sales of ornamental nursery stock, but only 149 (127) included a report on the value of products sold. Similarly there were 137 (112) firms with sales of fruit stock items but only 88 (78) of them reported value figures. Table 1 shows the total figures reported in all cases; thus the value data do not cover all sales of nursery stock reported in the different classes in this table.

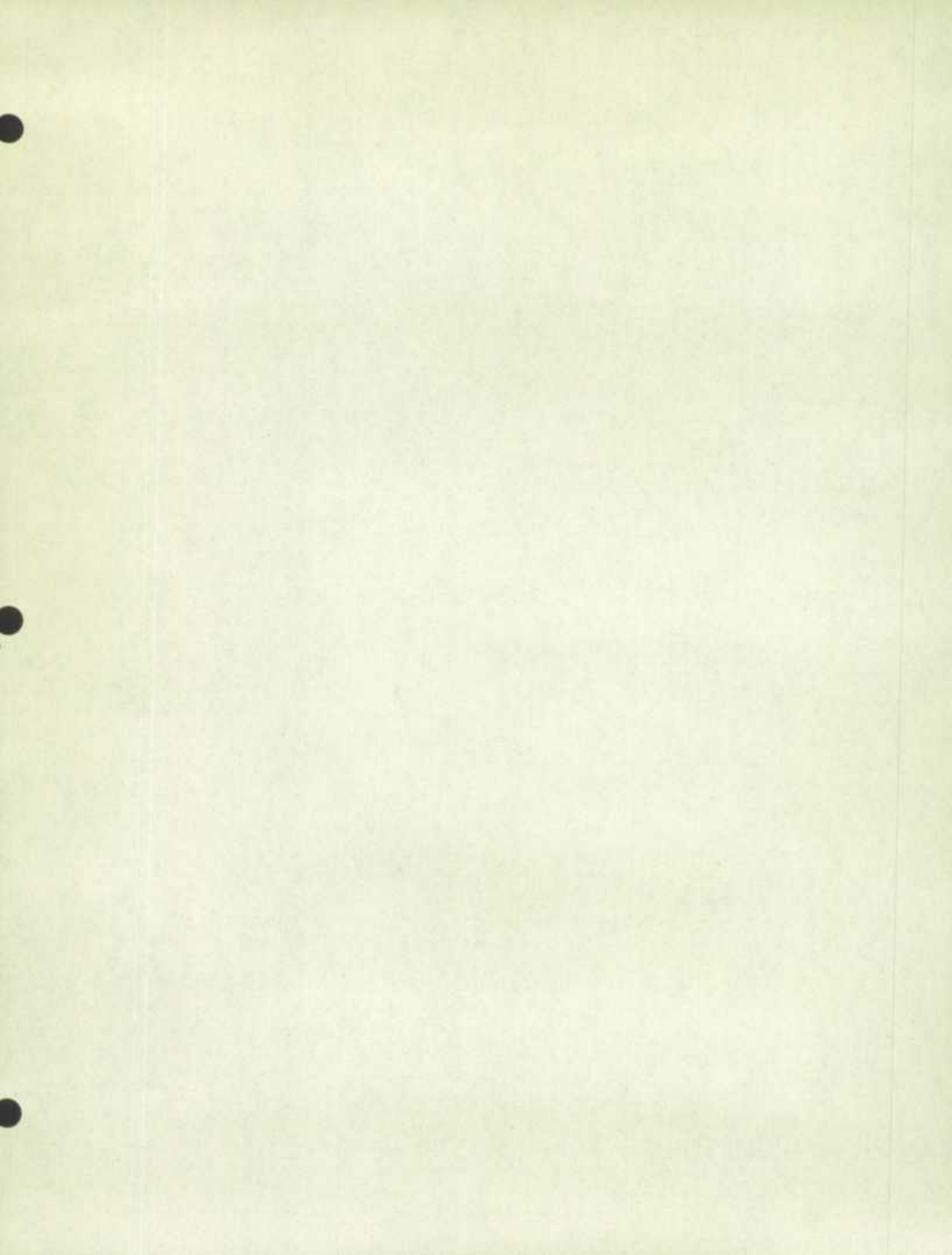

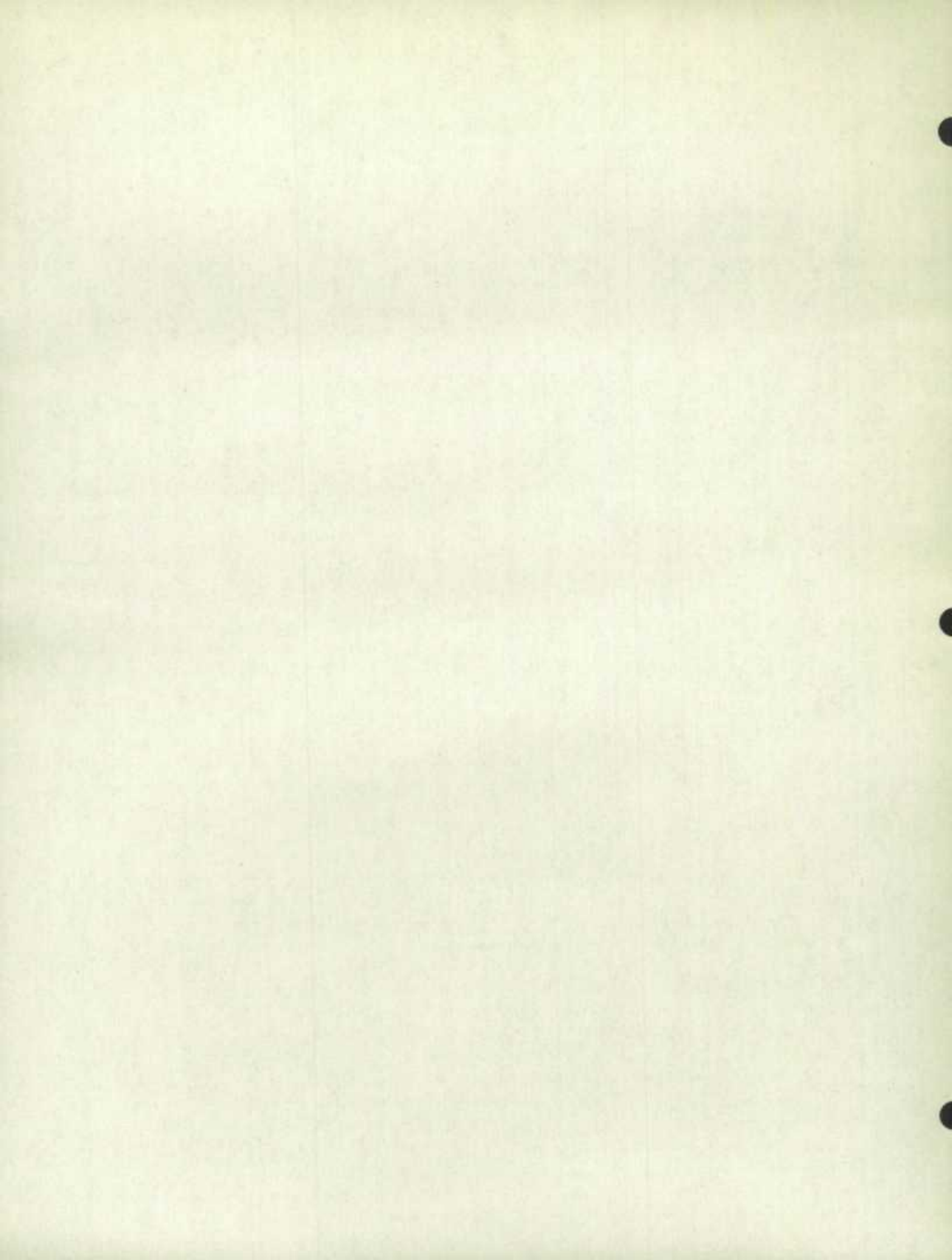
