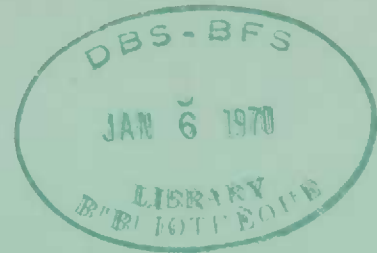

INTRODUCTION

Statistics concerning the nursery stock industry in Canada for the years 1967 and 1968 are presented in the accompanying tables. This material was compiled from the results of surveys undertaken in 1968 and 1969 in which questionnaires were sent to all nurseries in Canada asking for a report on the sales of nursery stock sold during 1967 and 1968 which the nurseries had propagated themselves, or grown on for twelve months or more.

Although questionnaires were sent to all nurseries it is not possible to get replies from every operator, however, it is believed that with very few exceptions, reports have been received from all major nurseries, and accordingly, the bulk of the industry is thought to be covered in the reports submitted.

A total of 347 nurseries reported sales of nursery stock for 1968 while in 1967, 264 reported. The number of nurseries reporting sales by province in 1968, with 1967 figures in brackets, are as follows: Ontario 172 (134), Quebec 52 (35), British Columbia 59 (55), Manitoba 23 (13), Maritimes 14 (11), Alberta and Saskatchewan 27 (16). Due to the variation in the number reporting from year to year, statistics for 1968 are not entirely comparable with those of 1967.

A summary of the total sales of nursery stock is shown in Table 1 and in Table 2 the total area planted to nursery stock reported by firms submitting reports to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is indicated. In 1968, with last year's figures in brackets, a total of 295 (225) nurseries reported sales of ornamental nursery stock, but only 245 (174) included a report on the value of products sold. Similarly there were 175 (142) firms with sales of fruit stock items but only 128 (100) of them reported value figures. Table 1 shows the total figures reported in all cases; thus the value data do not cover all sales of nursery stock reported in the different classes in this table.

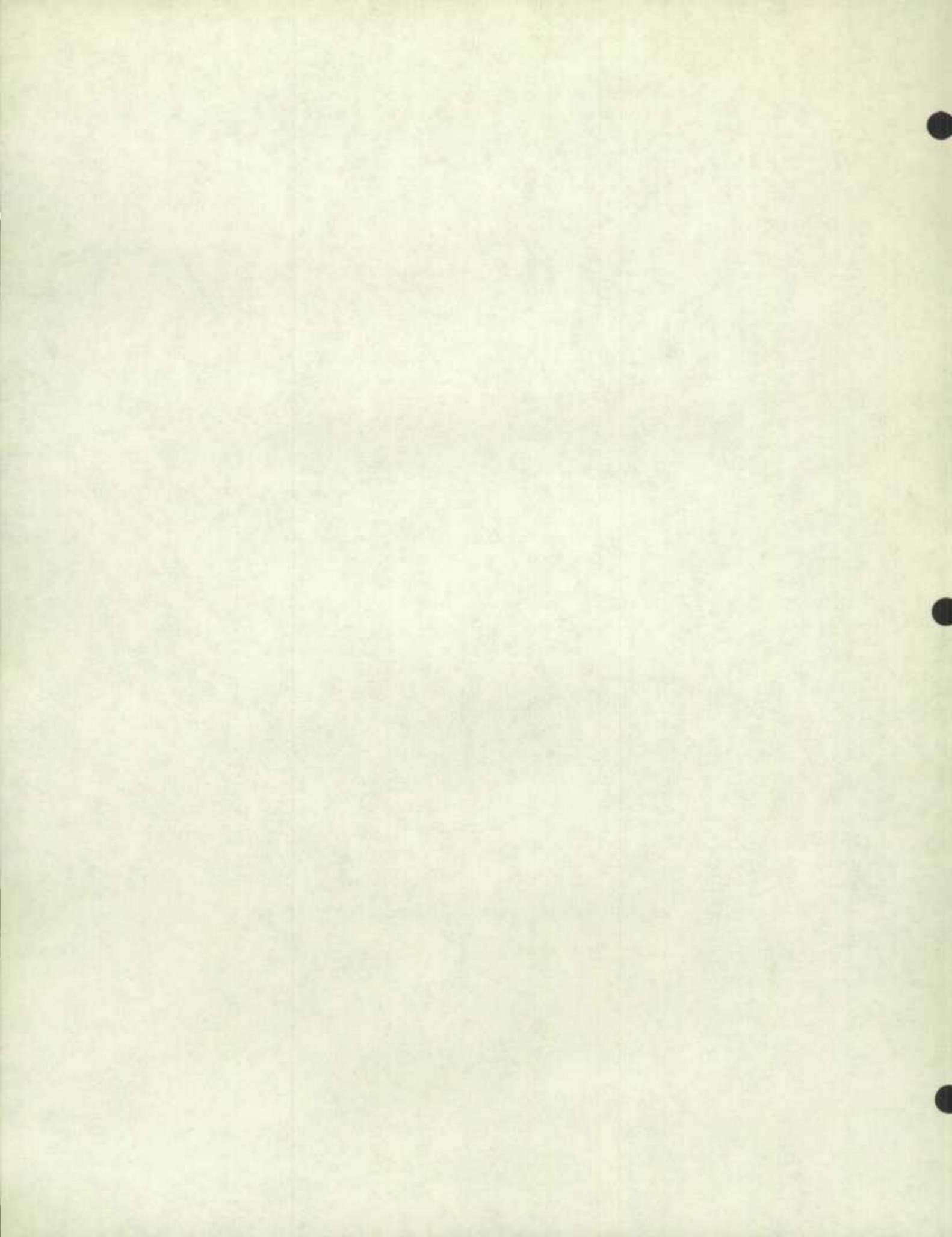
