MAPLE PRODUCTS

Production and Value 1/

Production of maple products this year was 20 per cent heavier than in 1949. Expressing syrup and sugar as syrup, there were 2,983,000 gallons of syrup made in. 1950 while in 1949 the total amounted to 2,485,000 gallons. There was an increase in the production of both maple syrup and maple sugar over last year. There were 2.801.000 gallons of syrup and 1.824.000 pounds of sugar made in 1950 compared with 2,306,000 gallons of syrup and 1,787,000 pounds of sugar made in the previous year. The average price received by farmers for syrup was 12 cents below the 1949 level. Sugar prices, on the other hand, remained unchanged. The average farm price this season was \$3.55 per gallon for syrup compared with \$3.67 a year ago. Farmers received an average of 37 cents a pound for sugar in both years.
